Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Knowing they have weak faith the apostles ask Jesus to strengthen their faith. But what is faith and how does it differ from trust? Faith is belief without proof, a sheer gift of God, often about unseen things, while trust is a firm belief based on demonstrated reliability and experience. One may have faith in a friend to keep a secret, but trust a mechanic to fix one's car based on past performance. Like the apostles, we lack great faith. We rely on Jesus to strengthen and fortify us. Faith involves trusting in something you cannot explicitly prove. Trust is the confidence that God can and will do what He says He will do. Faith without trust is not faith. Belief without reliance is incomplete. Many participate and rely on the Divine Mercy Novena, which repeatedly states, "Jesus, I trust in you." Logically we know that the Plan of God will always work out, even better than we could have designed it. Yet still we continue to beseech God to intercede for us. Not because God does not know what we want, rather because He wants us to ask so that we turn to Him in confidence. To increase our faith, we need to engage in prayer and meditation, study the Bible and actively seek fellowship with believers. It is beneficial for us to put faith into action by serving others, practicing gratitude, cultivate humility and embrace moments of wonder in creation. In essence, we do not have to wait to "feel great faith", rather we act in faith and trust that it will grow. And it will.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

Sabiendo que su fe era débil, los apóstoles le pidieron a Jesús que la fortaleciera. Pero ¿qué es la fe y en qué se diferencia de la confianza? La fe es creer sin pruebas, un don puro de Dios, a menudo sobre cosas invisibles, mientras que la confianza es una creencia firme basada en la fiabilidad y la experiencia demostradas. Uno puede tener fe en un amigo para guardar un secreto, pero confiar en un mecánico para que le arregle el coche basándose en su desempeño pasado. Al igual que los apóstoles, carecemos de una gran fe. Confiamos en Jesús para que nos fortalezca y nos fortalezca. La fe implica confiar en algo que no se puede probar explícitamente. La confianza es la certeza de que Dios puede y hará lo que dice que hará. La fe sin confianza no es fe. La creencia sin confianza es incompleta. Muchos participan y confían en la Novena a la Divina Misericordia, que dice repetidamente: «Jesús, confío en ti». Lógicamente, sabemos que el Plan de Dios siempre funcionará, incluso mejor de lo que podríamos haberlo diseñado. Sin embargo, seguimos suplicando a Dios que interceda por nosotros. No porque Dios desconozca lo que queremos, sino porque desea que se lo pidamos para que nos dirijamos a Él con confianza. Para acrecentar nuestra fe, necesitamos orar y meditar, estudiar la Biblia y buscar activamente la comunión con los creyentes. Nos beneficia poner nuestra fe en acción sirviendo a los demás, practicando la gratitud, cultivando la humildad y disfrutando de los momentos de asombro en la creación. En esencia, no tenemos que esperar a sentir una gran fe; más bien, actuamos con fe y confiamos en que crecerá. Y así será.
