What we treasure reveals a lot about our hearts. "For where your treasure is, there also your heart will be." How we spend our time and treasure demonstrates our priorities. Some of us spend time watching TV or on the internet, engaging in sports, hobbies, exercise, shopping or politics. But do our priorities line up with God's? Do we give sacrificially to worthy causes? Do we defend the faith against those who deride it? How we approach alms-giving says a lot. Some of us give generously to every cause. Some give and expect a "payback" of blessings and graces from God. Some give begrudgingly, as if the money belonged only to them. They do not realize that everything comes from God. These ungrateful people fail to realize if God had not gifted them with initiative and intelligence, they would not have acquired any wealth. Some of us do not realize that we are only stewards of our money, which is loaned to us from God. He wants to see how we distribute his gifts of money, talent and time to enjoy them. Do we give to the poor, despite the way in which they present? Do we give to our Church, seminaries? Do we defend the unborn who can not speak for themselves against abortion? Do they deserve a death sentence for daring to be born? To refuse to accept God's gifts is refuse to accept God. Like the parable says: When the master arrived finding his faithful servant doing the job for which he was given, the master will "put the servant in charge of all his property." Likewise the servant who ignores the master's orders will "be beaten severely and assigned to a place with the unfaithful."

Algunos pasamos el tiempo viendo la televisión o en internet, practicando deportes, aficiones, haciendo ejercicio, comprando o en política. Pero ¿nuestras prioridades coinciden con las de Dios? ¿Damos con sacrificio a causas dignas? ¿Defendemos la fe de quienes la menosprecian? Nuestra forma de dar limosna dice mucho. Algunos damos generosamente a todas las causas. Algunos dan y esperan una "retribución" de bendiciones y gracias de Dios. Algunos dan a regañadientes, como si el dinero les perteneciera solo a ellos. No se dan cuenta de que todo viene de Dios. Estas personas desagradecidas no se dan cuenta de que si Dios no les hubiera dado iniciativa e inteligencia, no habrían adquirido riquezas. Algunos no nos damos cuenta de que solo somos administradores de nuestro dinero, que Dios nos ha prestado. Él quiere ver cómo distribuimos sus dones de dinero, talento y tiempo para disfrutarlos. ¿Damos a los pobres, a pesar de su forma de presentarse? ¿Damos a nuestra Iglesia y seminarios? ¿Defendemos a los no nacidos que no pueden defenderse contra el aborto? ¿Merecen la pena de muerte por atreverse a nacer? Negarse a aceptar los dones de Dios es negarse a aceptar a Dios. Como dice la parábola: Cuando el amo llegó y encontró a su siervo fiel haciendo el trabajo para el cual se le encomendó, el amo "lo puso a cargo de todos sus bienes". Del mismo modo, el siervo que ignora las órdenes del amo "será azotado severamente y enviado a un lugar con los infieles".
