**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

"Do you think I have come to establish peace? No, I tell you, but rather division." This disturbing statement appears in direct opposition to Christianity's seemingly peaceful olive branch. Jesus acknowledges that division will be expected, rather than bliss and to take up our crosses and follow him. Upon conversion, most don't expect divided households of brother against brother, mother in law against daughter in law and friend against friend. But rather than denying that obstacles will face us, Jesus is saying obstacles should be expected. He does not promise a rose garden, but rather a rocky path in following him. Many Christians face isolation, persecution and ostracism when relating their faith to family and friends. Those closest to us may be "put off" and consider us "religious fanatics" if we openly practice our faith. Others will judge our faults and portray us as hypocrites if we don't agree with their opinions. The evil one will target those with prayerful ministries and drive a wedge between fellow Christians. But Our Lord anticipates that crosses will come our way, despite having faith or not. Many will outright reject this logic, thinking they will avoid crosses if they avoid religion. But God will test our meddle in how we accept, carry and handle these crosses. Although initially resistant, following the Lord means we offer our sufferings back to him, even thanking him for testing our faith and allowing our compliance. We take courage that Our Lord suffered at the hands of others and so must we. To bear wrongs patiently allows us to suffer temporarily in this world, while storing spiritual treasures in the next. When the illumination of consciences occurs, all things will be brought to light, allowing Our Lord to vindicate and rectify any injustice.

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy'. But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." Mt. 5:43-44

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

"¿Pensáis que he venido a traer paz? Os digo que no, sino división". Esta inquietante afirmación parece estar en directa oposición a la aparentemente pacífica rama de olivo del cristianismo. Jesús reconoce que se esperará división, en lugar de felicidad, y que debemos tomar nuestras cruces y seguirlo. Tras la conversión, la mayoría no espera hogares divididos de hermano contra hermano, suegra contra nuera y amigo contra amigo. Pero en lugar de negar que nos enfrentaremos a obstáculos, Jesús dice que debemos esperarlos. No promete un jardín de rosas, sino un camino pedregoso al seguirlo. Muchos cristianos se enfrentan al aislamiento, la persecución y el ostracismo al compartir su fe con familiares y amigos. Nuestros seres queridos pueden sentirse "desanimados" y considerarnos "fanáticos religiosos" si practicamos abiertamente nuestra fe. Otros juzgarán nuestras faltas y nos tacharán de hipócritas si no estamos de acuerdo con sus opiniones. El maligno atacará a quienes tienen ministerios de oración y creará una división entre los cristianos. Pero Nuestro Señor anticipa que nos encontraremos con cruces, tengamos fe o no. Muchos rechazarán rotundamente esta lógica, pensando que evitarán las cruces si evitan la religión. Pero Dios pondrá a prueba nuestra intromisión en cómo aceptamos, llevamos y manejamos estas cruces. Aunque al principio nos resistamos, seguir al Señor significa que le ofrecemos nuestros sufrimientos, incluso agradeciéndole por probar nuestra fe y permitir nuestra sumisión. Nos llena de valor que Nuestro Señor sufrió a manos de otros, y nosotros también debemos hacerlo. Soportar las injusticias con paciencia nos permite sufrir temporalmente en este mundo, mientras atesoramos tesoros espirituales en el venidero. Cuando se produzca la iluminación de las conciencias, todo saldrá a la luz, permitiendo que Nuestro Señor reivindique y rectifique cualquier injusticia.
