Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

My mom often related how my deceased father cried out in prayer over the death of stillborn older brother. Knowing my dad was so impacted by the baby's death somehow makes him more human and accessible. Since he was killed in a military accident, I grew up without a father. It is said that those who had a poor relationship with their own earthly fathers have a poor relationship with God the Father. Often because of neglect, abandonment, death or divorce, some have a poor relationship with their earthly fathers. Our society often brands "dead beat" dads, incarcerated men, Peter Pan womanizers and trophy-wife husbands as the reason our young are in such turmoil. It is easy to place blame on this type of father, but what about all the good fathers who do not deserve such a reputation? What about all the kind neighborhood men who loan tools, carry groceries, offer rides and attend mass consistently? What about the men who lead retreats, teach Confirmation and sing in the choir? Jesus is pointing out how approachable God the Father truly is. He is a person in which to have a relationship with us. He is a father who looks after our needs, whom we seek for sustenance, forgiveness and mercy. Our Catechism says we can be bold in addressing God as Father because Jesus has called us to a close relationship with himself and made us children of God. God never ceases to be the Father of his children. "All creatures are children of the one Father and therefore brothers." St. Francis of Assisi.

Mi madre solía contar cómo mi difunto padre lloró en oración por la muerte de su hermano mayor, que nació muerto. Saber que mi padre quedó tan impactado por la muerte del bebé, de alguna manera, lo hace más humano y accesible. Desde que falleció en un accidente militar, crecí sin padre. Se dice que quienes tuvieron una mala relación con sus padres terrenales, también tienen una mala relación con Dios Padre. A menudo, debido a la negligencia, el abandono, la muerte o el divorcio, algunos tienen una mala relación con sus padres terrenales. Nuestra sociedad a menudo tilda a los padres "irresponsables", a los hombres encarcelados, a los mujeriegos de Peter Pan y a los maridos-esposas como la causa de que nuestros jóvenes estén en tal crisis. Es fácil culpar a este tipo de padre, pero ¿qué pasa con todos los buenos padres que no merecen tal reputación? ¿Qué pasa con todos los amables hombres del barrio que prestan herramientas, llevan la compra, ofrecen transporte y asisten a misa con regularidad? ¿Qué pasa con los hombres que dirigen retiros, enseñan la Confirmación y cantan en el coro? Jesús está señalando lo accesible que es realmente Dios Padre. Él es una persona con la que podemos relacionarnos. Es un padre que vela por nuestras necesidades, a quien buscamos para recibir sustento, perdón y misericordia. Nuestro Catecismo dice que podemos ser audaces al dirigirnos a Dios como Padre porque Jesús nos llamó a una relación íntima con él y nos hizo hijos de Dios. Dios nunca deja de ser el Padre de sus hijos.
