Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel seems to culminate in the whole point of Jesus' ministry: the faith is to be shared. As usual, the apostles are slow to grasp what Our Lord is trying to convey. Despite past weeks of extraordinary miracles witnessed by them and thousands of others, they continue to be perplexed as to Christ's identity. They say: "Who is it that even the winds and seas obey him?" Throughout the last few months, the disciples are astounded by the power of Jesus to multiply food, raise the dead, calm storms and expel demons. Yet the seventy-two sent on mission are enthused that they now have the power to expel demons, rather than being hand-picked by God to be his faith spreading disciples. This message resounds in the worldwide Jubilee year of hope, the call to pilgrims and our own church's quest for teachers. Like the apostles we can not share what we don't have. But we can share our limited faith with others and learn along with them, expanding our own knowledge base as we learn. To teach is to become a "missionary", fostering student learning and development, guiding them to become well-rounded Catholics. We are Christ for others. This means that every genuine Christian would like God to come to others as well. If you have a passion to inspire and shape young minds, consider expanding your ministry to include a year of teaching catechism.

¡El evangelio de hoy parece culminar en el propósito central del ministerio de Jesús: compartir la fe. Como de costumbre, los apóstoles tardan en comprender lo que Nuestro Señor intenta transmitir. A pesar de las semanas pasadas de milagros extraordinarios presenciados por ellos y miles de otros, siguen perplejos respecto a la identidad de Cristo. Dicen: "¿Quién es, que hasta los vientos y los mares le obedecen?". Durante los últimos meses, los discípulos se han asombrado por el poder de Jesús para multiplicar los alimentos, resucitar muertos, calmar tormentas y expulsar demonios. Sin embargo, los setenta y dos enviados en misión están entusiasmados porque ahora tienen el poder de expulsar demonios, en lugar de haber sido escogidos por Dios para ser sus discípulos propagadores de la fe. Este mensaje resuena en el Jubileo mundial de esperanza, el llamado a los peregrinos y la búsqueda de maestros por parte de nuestra iglesia. Al igual que los apóstoles, no podemos compartir lo que no tenemos. Pero podemos compartir nuestra fe limitada con otros y aprender junto con ellos, ampliando nuestro propio conocimiento a medida que aprendemos. Enseñar es convertirse en un "misionero", fomentando el aprendizaje y el desarrollo de los estudiantes, guiándolos para convertirse en católicos integrales. Somos Cristo para los demás. Esto significa que todo cristiano genuino desea que Dios también venga a los demás. Si te apasiona inspirar y formar mentes jóvenes, considera ampliar tu ministerio para incluir un año de catecismo.
