Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The gospel and the readings emphasize bread and wine as a prefigurement of the Eucharist or the Body and Blood of Jesus. Our Catechism states that the Holy Eucharist is the sacrament in which Jesus Christ gives us his Body and Blood- so that we might give ourselves to him in returned love and be united with him in Holy Communion, in this way we are joined with the one Body of Christ--the Church. We are not Church because we happen to end up in the same parish community, but rather because in the Eucharist we receive the Body of Christ and are increasingly being transformed into the body of Christ. The celebration of the Eucharist is the heart of the Christian communion because within it, we become Church. When we eat the broken bread, we unite ourselves with the love of Jesus, who gave his body for us on the wood of the Cross. In John 6, "Unless you eat my body and drink my blood, there is no life in you". Eating and drinking is believing because Jesus promises eternal life to those who believe in him. Christ emphasizes the importance of believing in him and accepting his sacrifice for our sins. Just as physical bread sustains our physical life, so Jesus the living bread sustains our spiritual lives.

"It was as though I heard a voice from on high: I am the food of the strong ; eat then of me and grow. But you will not transform me into yourself like food for the body, but rather you will be transformed into me." St. Augustine (354-430) at the time of his conversion.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

¡El Evangelio y las lecturas enfatizan el pan y el vino como prefiguración de la Eucaristía, o el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Nuestro Catecismo afirma que la Sagrada Eucaristía es el sacramento en el que Jesucristo nos da su Cuerpo y su Sangre para que nos entreguemos a él en reciprocidad y nos unamos a él en la Sagrada Comunión. De esta manera, nos unimos al único Cuerpo de Cristo: la Iglesia. No somos Iglesia porque pertenezcamos a la misma comunidad parroquial, sino porque en la Eucaristía recibimos el Cuerpo de Cristo y nos transformamos cada vez más en el Cuerpo de Cristo. La celebración de la Eucaristía es el corazón de la comunión cristiana porque en ella nos convertimos en Iglesia. Al comer el pan partido, nos unimos al amor de Jesús, quien entregó su cuerpo por nosotros en el madero de la cruz. En Juan 6: «Si no comen mi cuerpo y beben mi sangre, no hay vida en ustedes». Comer y beber es creer porque Jesús promete la vida eterna a quienes creen en él. Cristo enfatiza la importancia de creer en él y aceptar su sacrificio por nuestros pecados. Así como el pan físico sustenta nuestra vida física, Jesús, el pan vivo, sustenta nuestra vida espiritual.
