Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel has always confused me. It seems like Jesus is commending dishonesty, but he is really pointing out the big picture. Many of us live only for the short term fix and fail to appreciate our future eternity. So similarly, the shrewd dishonest steward is discounting the debts owed to his master so as to insure his future success once he is let go. The dishonest steward thinks he will make friends of those to whom he offered a discount. Shortchanging the present in order to ensure a brighter future is dicey at best. But many think this way. We are the stewards of what God has given us, so we are free to give away the wealth and gifts with which God has blessed us. But rather than "give away" our resources, many hoard and cling to their material goods. We selfishly think that we "deserve" our wealth and do not want to share it. Ironically all the wealth in which we have been entrusted, would not be ours without God having given it to us. So, on judgement day, God our master will ask us how we used all the gifts/wealth/blessings to which he loaned us. The key to understanding this is the last few sentences. "If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours? No servant can serve two masters; He will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Mammon."

El evangelio de hoy siempre me ha confundido. Parece que Jesús elogia la deshonestidad, pero en realidad señala el panorama general. Muchos vivimos solo para el corto plazo y no apreciamos nuestra futura eternidad. De igual manera, el administrador astuto y deshonesto descuenta las deudas con su amo para asegurar su éxito futuro una vez que lo despidan. El administrador deshonesto cree que se hará amigo de aquellos a quienes ofreció un descuento. Defraudar el presente para asegurar un futuro mejor es, en el mejor de los casos, arriesgado. Pero muchos piensan así. Somos administradores de lo que Dios nos ha dado, por lo que somos libres de regalar la riqueza y los dones con los que Dios nos ha bendecido. Pero en lugar de "regalar" nuestros recursos, muchos atesoran y se aferran a sus bienes materiales. Pensamos egoístamente que "merecemos" nuestra riqueza y no queremos compartirla. Irónicamente, toda la riqueza que se nos ha confiado no sería nuestra si Dios no nos la hubiera dado. Así, en el día del juicio, Dios, nuestro amo, nos preguntará cómo usamos todos los dones, riquezas y bendiciones que nos prestó. La clave para entender esto son las últimas frases: «Si no eres fiel con lo ajeno, ¿quién te dará lo tuyo? Ningún siervo puede servir a dos señores; o aborrecerá a uno y amará al otro, o se apegará a uno y despreciará al otro. No se puede servir a Dios y a Mammón».
