Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

"Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough." But what does it mean to enter through the narrow gate? If there are two choices in life symbolized by gates, one is wide and easily traversed by many, the other narrow and challenging in which just a few can negotiate. The wide gate path is strewn with tempting diversions and worldly destructive influences. However, the narrow gate requires effort, to follow a path of genuine sacrificial love and adherence to God's will. The wide gate signifies the ways of the secular world in which sin abounds. The narrow gate leads to true life and salvation if we surrender to God's will, his righteousness and forgive others. And here lies the problem because most of us want to attain a heavenly entrance, but it is difficult to turn off the world, ignore temptations and lead a saintly life. Many obstacles will block our entrance from difficult people and sinful diversions to road rage and gossiping. Most people think they are going to heaven, even if they have a stop over in Purgatory. However, Matthew 7:13-14 says differently. "But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life and only a few find it." Formed.org stresses that to love God is to be in contempt of ourselves. Dying to self and "stretching" ourselves to love the unlovable, forgive the unrepentant and sacrifice for sinners requires fortitude. When we don't retaliate, suffer wrongs patiently or give into our moods, we build virtue and moral courage. This makes us strong enough to enter into the narrow gate.

Prayer for a narrow gate: "Help me to walk through the narrow gate even when it is hard. Give me strength to turn away from the things that pull me off the path. In His name, I pray. Amen."

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta estrecha, porque les digo que muchos intentarán entrar, pero no serán lo suficientemente fuertes. Pero ¿qué significa entrar por la puerta estrecha? Si hay dos opciones en la vida simbolizadas por puertas, una es ancha y fácil de atravesar para muchos, la otra es estrecha y desafiante, y solo unos pocos pueden sortearla. El camino de la puerta ancha está plagado de tentaciones y destructivas influencias mundanas. Sin embargo, la puerta estrecha requiere esfuerzo, para seguir un camino de genuino amor sacrificial y adhesión a la voluntad de Dios. La puerta ancha representa las costumbres del mundo secular, en el que abunda el pecado. La puerta estrecha conduce a la verdadera vida y a la salvación si nos sometemos a la voluntad de Dios, a su justicia, y perdonamos a los demás. Y aquí radica el problema, porque la mayoría deseamos alcanzar la entrada celestial, pero es difícil desconectarnos del mundo, ignorar las tentaciones y llevar una vida santa. Muchos obstáculos bloquearán nuestra entrada: desde personas difíciles y desviaciones pecaminosas hasta la ira al volante y el chismorreó. La mayoría de la gente cree que irá al cielo, incluso si hace una escala en el Purgatorio. Sin embargo, Mateo 7:13-14 dice algo diferente: «Estrecha es la puerta y angosto el camino que lleva a la vida, y pocos la encuentran». Formed.org enfatiza que amar a Dios es despreciarse a sí mismo. Morir a uno mismo y esforzarse por amar a los que no merecen amor, perdonar a los impenitentes y sacrificarse por los pecadores requiere fortaleza. Cuando no nos vengamos, sufrimos las injusticias con paciencia ni nos dejamos llevar por nuestros cambios de humor, cultivamos la virtud y la valentía moral. Esto nos fortalece para entrar por la puerta estrecha.

Oración por la puerta estrecha: «Ayúdame a cruzar la puerta estrecha incluso cuando sea difícil. Dame fuerza para alejarme de las cosas que me desvían del camino. En su nombre, te lo ruego. Amén».
