#### 2025-2026 Requirements & Responsibilities

#### 1st Year Faith Formation

- Bring child(ren) to class weekly on time. Child(ren) are to arrive no later than 15 minutes. Tardiness disrupts the class. Child(ren) must attend 22 of the 24 formation classes per year. per Diocesan Policy.
- Only two (2) absents per year per Diocesan Policy. If absence due to illness, family emergency or death of family Will be excused. Notice of absence to the office in writing.
- Child(ren) must have book at each session to ensure quality participation and faith growth.
- Weekly Family page at end of each chapter to be completed at home with parent.
- ❖ Teach / Pray with your child(ren) the Catholic prayers. The Catechists will pray at each session, but is your responsibility as the primary catechist of the faith to teach them the prayers.
- Attend Mass weekly (every Sunday). To enrich the faith life of your child(ren) attending Mass is an integral part of their faith journey to the table of the Lord.
- Attend four (4) Holy Hours per year
- Attend four (4) Adult Faith Formation sessions per year
- Attend Parent Retreat (1st Year Faith Formation)
- Child(ren) must know prayers by memory before the end of the first year of formation.

#### 2nd Year Sacramental Preparation

- 2nd Year child(ren) must know prayers prior to registering for 2nd Year formation classes.
- Only two (2) absents per year per Diocesan Policy. If absence due to illness, family emergency or death of family Will be excused. Notice of absence to the office in writing.
- Child(ren) must have book at each session to ensure quality participation and faith growth.
- ❖ Weekly Family page at end of each chapter to be completed at home with parent.
- ❖ Teach / Pray with your child(ren) the Catholic prayers. The Catechists will pray at each session, but is your responsibility as the primary catechist of the faith to teach them the prayers.
- Attend Mass weekly (every Sunday). To enrich the faith life of your child(ren) attending Mass is an integral part of their faith journey to the table of the Lord.
