Baptismal Program

Dear Parents,

Congratulations for seeking to have your child baptized. The Sacrament of Baptism marks a very important point in the spiritual life of your child and of the Church. Through this first Sacrament of Initiation, your child is welcomed into the community of God's family. Because it is so significant, and to meet the requirements of Canon Law, the following Parish policy has been established for the Baptism of children who have not reached the age of reason, usually about seven years of age. Parents and godparents are required pre-Baptism formation (Canon 851.2).

In order to register for this formation,

- Please fill out the **Baptismal Registration forms**. When filling in the information, please print legibly as this information will be used for the Baptismal Record. Turn in the completed form, with a **copy of your child's Birth Certificate** (showing child's name, parent's names including mother's maiden name, date and place of birth)
- Have **Godparent's complete and sign Godparent form**. **GODPARENTS MUST PROVIDE US A COPY OF THEIR CONFIRMATION CERTIFICATE AND IF MARRIED, A COPY OF THEIR CATHOLIC MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE**
- **\$75.00 Administrative Fee** (covering pre-baptismal class costs, administrative fees, supplies, etc.; no other fees are required for Baptism) to the Faith Formation Office.
- The completed baptismal packet should be turned in prior to the deadline. Pre-baptismal classes take place one month prior to the baptism date.

Additionally, the Baptism date for your child will not be confirmed until the **parents and godparents have attended pre-Baptism classes**, we respectfully request that you not make plans for a particular date until then. As a reminder Canon 857.2 sets as a rule that infants are to be baptized in the "parish church proper to their parents" (either living within the Parish boundaries or registered as members). If this is not the case, please request a **letter of permission** to baptize outside of the parish, particularly if it is not a parish of the Diocese of San Bernardino.

Finally, Canon 872, 873, and 874 requires you to have at least one godparent (you may have two; one godmother and one godfather) who is at least sixteen years old; has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist; and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken (i.e. a practicing Catholic: regularly attending Mass; receiving the Sacraments; if married, married in the Church). Although other Christians may stand as witnesses to the Baptism, they are only Christian Witnesses, not godparents.

Dear Baptismal Godparent:

When a parent chooses you as a Baptismal godparent that means you are thought of as a very special Catholic. Being called to be a godparent is not merely a choice because of family ties or a reward of friendship. The call to be a godparent bears the responsibility of giving spiritual witness to your godchild of how to live out the Catholic faith in everyday life. By being faithful to God's law, being active in the life of the parish, participating in Mass weekly, and living Gospel values, you offer tremendous personal support to the parents who commit themselves in Baptism to faithfully passing on the Catholic faith to their child. Therefore, it is important that you prayerfully consider the serious responsibility, which you take on as a godparent. If you are unable to live up to these Catholic ideals, you may wish to decline this responsibility.

The Canon Law of the Catholic Church offers these qualities of a valid godparent (**select all that apply**):

- ☐ Must be mature enough to undertake this role, at least 16 years of age.
- ☐ Must not be the mother or father of the one to be baptized. The godparent, with the parents, presents the child for the sacrament and helps him/her live a life befitting a baptized Catholic Christian.
- ☐ Must be fully initiated, having received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist
- ☐ Must know the fundamental truths of the faith, be a practicing Catholic who attends Sunday Mass and receives the sacraments regularly, and sees to the religious instruction of his/her family.

[This would indicate that Catholics living in an invalid marriage (not according to Roman Catholic Church regulations) and those who are cohabiting (living together without marriage) are ineligible.]

I affirm that I am a baptized and confirmed Catholic, living my Catholic faith and in good standing with the Catholic Church. I understand that I am called to serve as a companion, guide, and role model to my godchild especially by my own example and witness.
