New Above-the-Line Deduction: Up to \$2,000

One of the biggest changes included in the legislation is the return and expansion of the above-the-line deduction for charitable contributions.

This means taxpayers can now deduct charitable donations **even if they don't itemize** - a win for many households.

- Up to \$2,000 for those filing jointly
- Up to \$1,000 for single filers or heads of household
