

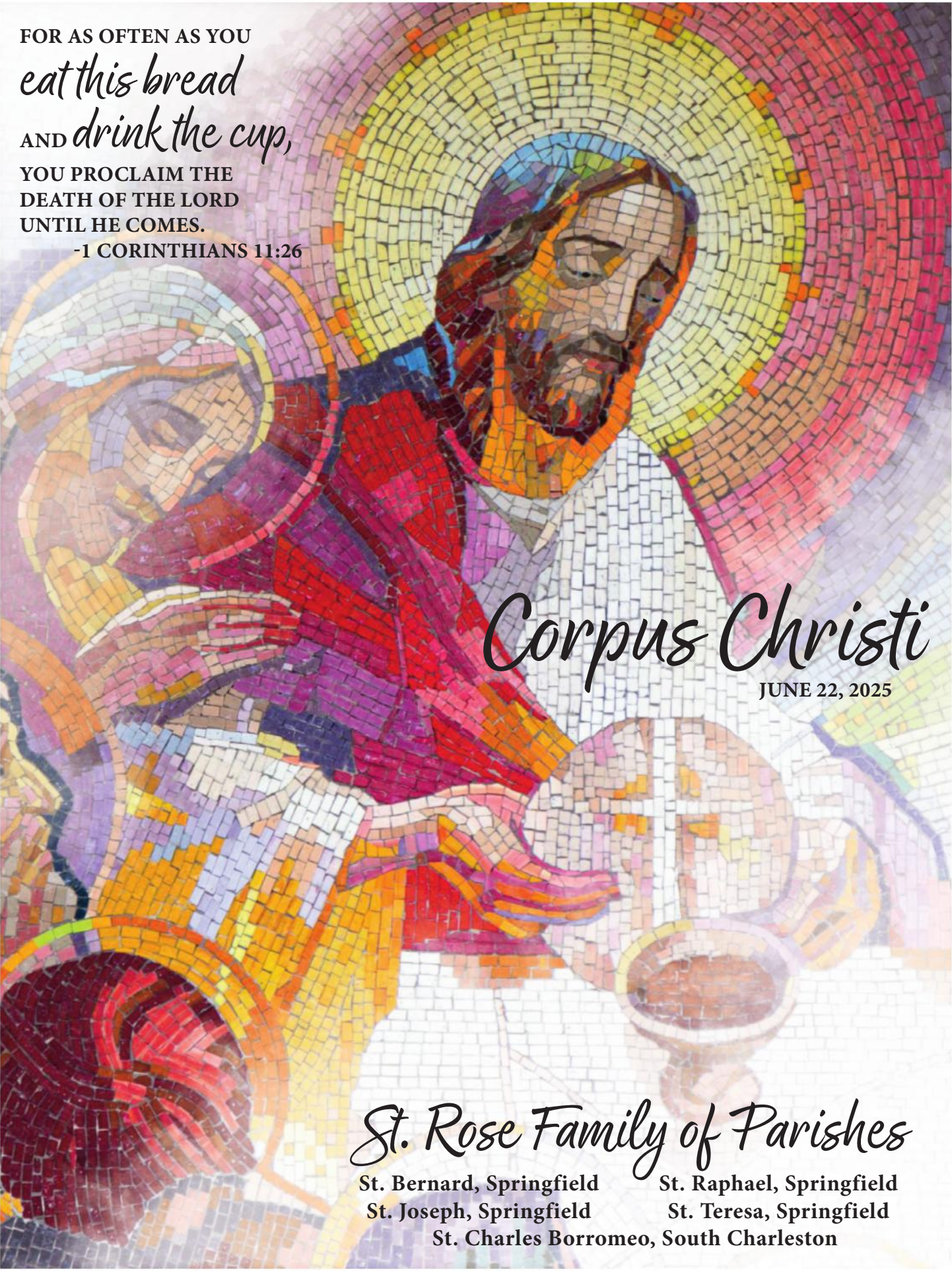

Pastor's Corner



From the Pastor, June 22, 2025

When I was growing up, I don't think I ever went to Eucharistic Adoration or knew what it was. Perhaps you also do not know what it is. I had never thought about the Eucharist, really – if you had asked me what the Eucharist is, I wouldn't have been able to tell you.

Little did I know that the Eucharist would become the most important part of my life. I was 20 years old when I first heard the truth about the Eucharist, that the bread and wine at Mass becomes truly the Body and Blood of Jesus through the praying of the Eucharistic Prayer by the priest, and I was invited to Eucharistic Adoration. In that time of Adoration, I profoundly encountered Jesus who was really present there – and this brought about a rapid and deep change for me.

I strongly encourage you to come to Eucharistic Adoration, to spend some time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. Encountering Jesus there radically changed my life – brought me into close relationship with Jesus, opened me up to receiving a call to the priesthood, and led me to where I am today. I end with some words that St. John Paul II spoke powerfully to young people in Bologna in 1997 about the Eucharist: "The Eucharist is the secret of my day. It gives strength and meaning to all my activities of service to the Church and to the whole world ... Let Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament speak to your hearts. It is he who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us: He is God with us. Seek him without tiring; welcome him without reserve; love him without interruption: today, tomorrow, forever!"

Cuando yo estaba creciendo, creo que nunca fui a la Adoración Eucarística ni sabía lo que era. Tal vez tú tampoco sepas lo que es. Nunca había pensado en la Eucaristía, realmente — si me hubieras preguntado qué es la Eucaristía, no habría podido decirte. No sabía que la Eucaristía se convertiría en la parte más importante de mi vida. Tenía 20 años cuando escuché por primera vez la verdad sobre la Eucaristía: que el pan y el vino en la Misa se convierten verdaderamente en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús por medio de la oración eucarística pronunciada por el sacerdote, y fui invitado a la Adoración Eucarística. En ese tiempo de adoración, encontré profundamente a Jesús, quien estaba realmente presente allí — y eso provocó un cambio rápido y profundo en mí.

Te animo encarecidamente a que vengas a la Adoración Eucarística, a pasar un tiempo con Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía. Encontrarme con Jesús allí cambió radicalmente mi vida — me llevó a una relación cercana con Jesús, me abrió a recibir un llamado al sacerdocio y me condujo hasta donde estoy hoy. Terminó con unas palabras que San Juan Pablo II dirigió poderosamente a los jóvenes en Bolonia en 1997 sobre la Eucaristía: "La Eucaristía es el secreto de mi jornada. Ella da fuerza y sentido a todos mis servicios a la Iglesia y a la humanidad entera ... Dejen que Jesús, presente en el Santísimo Sacramento, hable a sus corazones. Él es quien da la verdadera respuesta a la vida que ustedes buscan. Él permanece aquí con nosotros: Él es Dios con nosotros. Búsquenlo sin cansarse; acójalo sin reservas; ámenlo sin interrupción: ¡hoy, mañana y siempre!"

Meetings with St. Rose Family Staff

As we have been discussing in these articles, Beacons of Light is a process of pastoral planning to best arrange all the resources of the archdiocese to proclaim the Gospel and make disciples in this particular time and place. And so at this point, we can shift gears a bit to see what has been done – what has your new pastor been doing in accord with this pastoral planning process?

Let's start at the beginning, when I came last fall. In addition to learning how to do a job that I have never done before (pastor of a parish) and trying to "just keep the boats afloat," I have been having a ton of meetings and consultations with staff and parishioners. My first goal, when I arrived, was to meet with all of my staff members individually. There are about two dozen and I met with all of them in the Fall of 2024. The first thing I wanted to do was thank them for their generous service to the Church. Our staff members work hard and I am grateful for each one of them. Then, I asked them questions like, "Are you happy in your role?" "What is your opinion on how things are going in the parish?" "What is the purpose of a Catholic parish anyway?" "Is there anything we can do better?" "Give me advice on how to do my new job." These were very fruitful questions to ask.

I have also instituted monthly all-staff meetings, mandatory for all staff members. There are many purposes to these meetings. I found that staff from different parishes had never even met each other, so the first goal is social. I also wanted to give the staff some formation as Christians – how to know, love, and live our Catholic faith. There is also a little space to inform them of where things are going and consult them on slight adjustments. All of this is working toward a single staff for our Family of Parishes. The individual meetings and all-staff meetings have generally been well received. Next time – we will continue to talk about what has been done already, with the formation of a leadership team.

Las Antorchas están Encendidas

Reuniones con el Personal de la Familia de Santa Rosa

Como hemos estado comentando en estos artículos, Beacons of Light es un proceso de planificación pastoral para organizar de la mejor manera posible todos los recursos de la arquidiócesis, con el fin de proclamar el Evangelio y formar discípulos en este tiempo y lugar concretos. Por eso, en este punto podemos cambiar un poco de enfoque y ver lo que ya se ha hecho – ¿qué ha estado haciendo su nuevo párroco en conformidad con este proceso de planificación pastoral?

Comencemos desde el principio, cuando llegué el otoño pasado. Además de aprender a hacer un trabajo que nunca antes había hecho (ser párroco de una parroquia) y tratar simplemente de "mantener los barcos a flote," he tenido muchísimas reuniones y consultas con el personal y con feligreses. Mi primer objetivo, al llegar, fue reunirme individualmente con todos los miembros del personal. Son unas dos docenas y me reuní con todos ellos en el otoño de 2024. Lo primero que quise hacer fue agradecerles por su generoso servicio a la Iglesia. Nuestro personal trabaja duro y estoy agradecido por cada uno de ellos. Luego les hice preguntas como: "¿Estás feliz en tu función?" "¿Cuál es tu opinión sobre cómo van las cosas en la parroquia?" "¿Cuál es el propósito de una parroquia católica, en tu opinión?" "¿Hay algo que podamos hacer mejor?" "Dame consejos sobre cómo hacer bien mi nuevo trabajo." Estas fueron preguntas muy fructíferas.

También he instituido reuniones mensuales de todo el personal, obligatorias para todos los miembros del equipo. Estas reuniones tienen muchos propósitos. Descubrí que el personal de diferentes parroquias ni siquiera se conocía, así que el primer objetivo es social. También quise ofrecer al personal formación cristiana – cómo conocer, amar y vivir nuestra fe católica. Además, hay un pequeño espacio para informarles hacia dónde vamos y consultarles sobre pequeños ajustes. Todo esto trabaja hacia una meta común: un solo equipo de personal para nuestra Familia de Parroquias. Las reuniones individuales y las reuniones generales del personal han sido, en general, bien recibidas.

La próxima vez, continuaremos hablando de lo que ya se ha hecho, incluyendo la formación de un equipo de liderazgo.

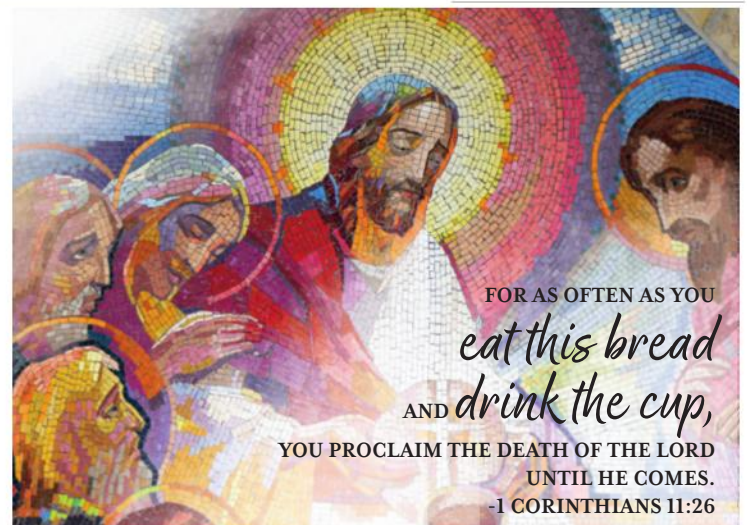

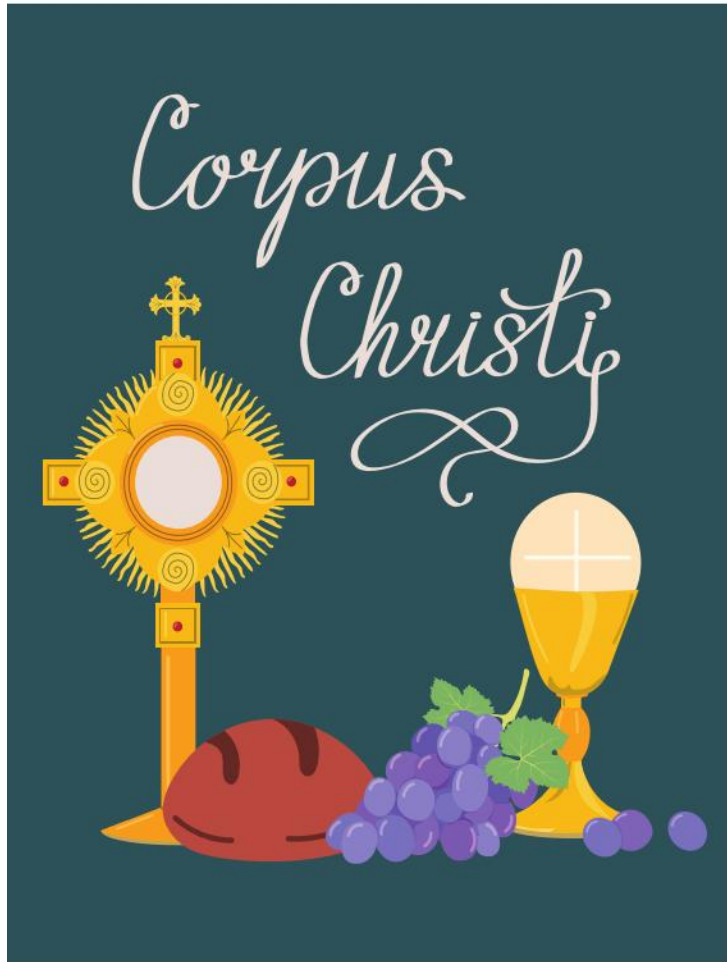

Saint Cyril of Alexandria

Saint of the Day: June 27

Patron Saint of Alexandria, Egypt

Saints are not born with halos around their heads. Cyril, recognized as a great teacher of the Church, began his career as archbishop of Alexandria, Egypt, with impulsive, often violent, actions. He pillaged and closed the churches of the Novatian heretics, participated in the deposing of Saint John Chrysostom, and confiscated Jewish property, expelling the Jews from Alexandria in retaliation for their attacks on Christians.

Cyril's importance for theology and Church history lies in his championing the cause of orthodoxy against the heresy of Nestorius, who taught that in Christ there were two persons, one human and one divine.

The controversy centered around the two natures in Christ. Nestorius would not agree to the title "God-bearer" for Mary. He preferred "Christ-bearer," saying there are two distinct persons in Christ – divine and human – joined only by a moral union. He said Mary was not the mother of God but only of the man Christ, whose humanity was only a temple of God. Nestorianism implied that the humanity of Christ was a mere disguise.

Presiding as the pope's representative at the Council of Ephesus in 431, Cyril condemned Nestorianism and proclaimed Mary truly the "God-bearer" – the mother of the one Person who is truly God and truly human. In the confusion that followed, Cyril was deposed and imprisoned for three months, after which he was welcomed back to Alexandria.

Cyril had difficulties with some of his own allies, who thought he had gone too far, sacrificing not only language but orthodoxy. Until his death, his policy of moderation kept his extreme partisans under control. On his deathbed, despite pressure, he refused to condemn the teacher of Nestorius.
