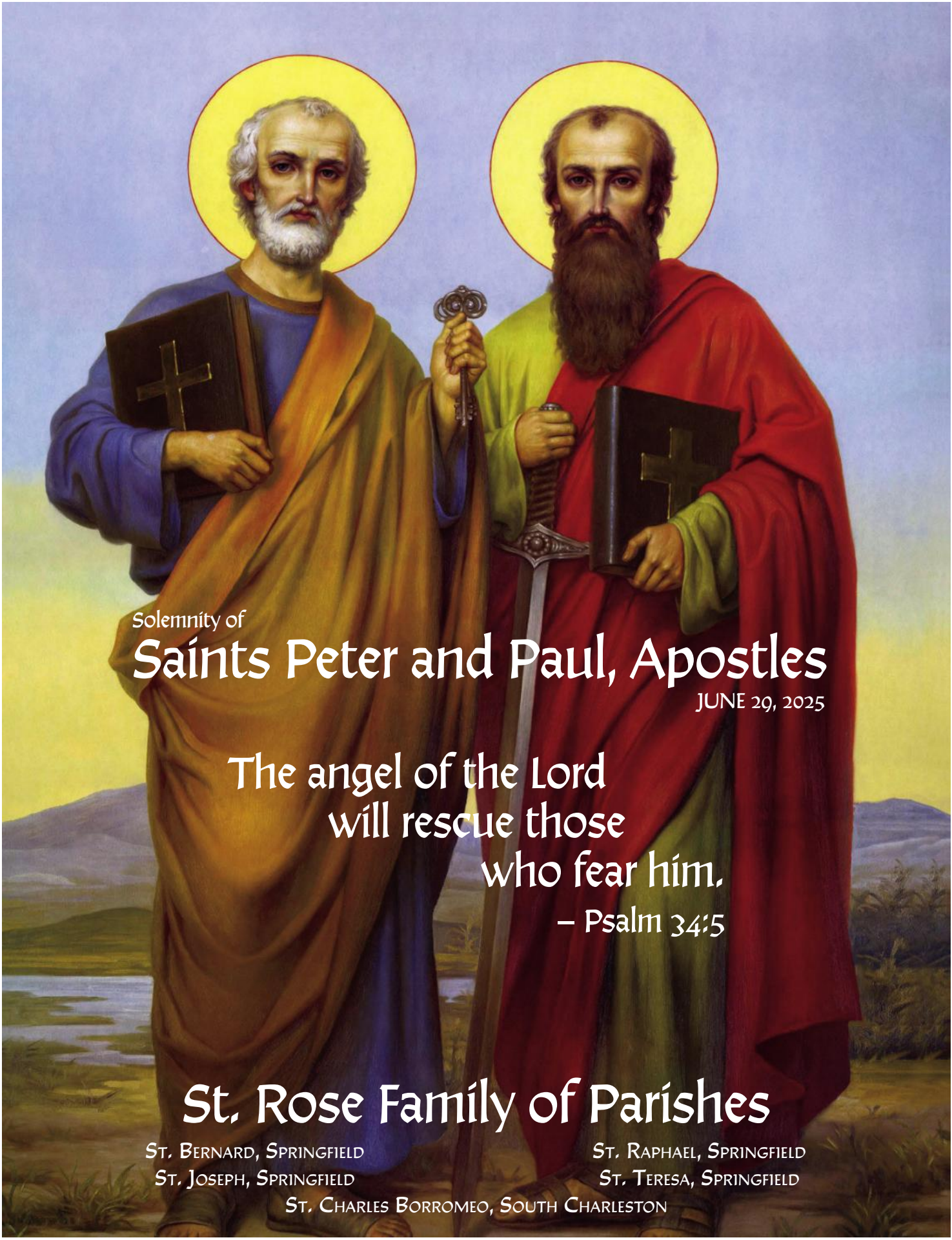

Forming a Leadership Team

As you know and as we will continue to repeat, Beacons of Light is a process of pastoral planning to best arrange all the resources of the archdiocese to proclaim the Gospel and make disciples in this particular time and place.

One of the things that I knew that I needed when I first started here in Springfield was a leadership team. I needed a group of close collaborators who had a unity of vision and purpose and the skills to be a great support for me. I can't be everywhere all at once, so to have a leadership team who all have an intimate understanding of the direction we need to go and the methods to achieve it multiplies my leadership impact. The members of the team also provide their unique strengths, which oftentimes furnishes me with great resources that I do not have myself. As you know, I am new to being a pastor and need to grow into my role here.

The current membership of the leadership team is as follows. The parochial vicar is on the team, since he and I should be united and I want to hear his input – so Fr. Elijah has been on it and Fr. Robert Hale will be on it. Chelsea Martinez, the Director of Administration, has been exemplary in her role and a great help on the leadership team. Ted Reilly, a retired VP in the steel industry and current consultant with the Beacons of Light process through the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, brings a ton of experience to the group. Gretchen Hovda, member of St. Bernard and current chairperson of the Family Pastoral Council, also brings a lot of experience of parish life in Springfield and of leading teams.

Ted Reilly, un vicepresidente retirado de la industria del acero y consultor actual del proceso Beacons of Light a través de la Oficina de la Cancillería de la Arquidiócesis de Cincinnati, aporta una gran experiencia al grupo. Gretchen Hovda, miembro de St. Bernard y actual presidenta del Consejo Pastoral Familiar, también aporta mucha experiencia de la vida parroquial en Springfield y del liderazgo de equipos.

Community

Reflection on Matthew 16:13-19

Forming community is a difficult task. Choosing to let others into our space, our lives, is a risky decision, in part because it means reaching out to people who are different from us: people who think and act differently, people less fortunate or more fortunate, people with different needs and perspectives.

Jesus chose these two odd fellows – Peter and Paul – not only to belong to His community of believers, but to lead it. And they are very different characters. Look at the symbols in Scripture presented here, which concretize how very different they remained: the symbol of the race for Paul, and of the rock for Peter. Paul is always on the move, making journey after journey to extend the faith to the known world. Peter was drawn to one place, Rome, which became the center-place, the home, the rock of Christianity.

Given the state of our world and our Church, it is good for us to reflect on the question of how we find unity in our differences. How does the Lord's choice of Peter and Paul help us see differences in another person in a positive, growth-oriented, and life-giving manner?

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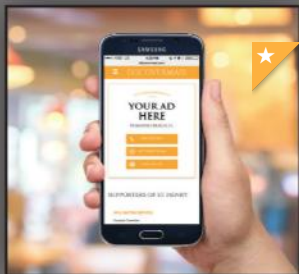
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
