## Pastor's Corner



### From the Pastor, July 20, 2025

There is an extraordinary religious order called the Carthusians, founded about 800 years ago by St. Bruno. They are some of the most intense monks that we have in the Catholic Church, committing themselves to a cloistered life with a limited internal community life, while spending most of their time in prayer. There is a powerful and beautiful movie called "Into Great Silence" which gives the viewer a glimpse inside the main Carthusian monastery in the world called "La Grande Chartreuse." Warning: it is 3 hours long and pretty much all silence – watching the movie itself is a contemplative experience.

From the secular point of view, these monks are crazy. Why would they go into the mountains and never talk to anyone anymore, even rarely talking to each other? What do they do all day? What is the point of it all? But from our point of view, we know that they have "chosen the better part," as Jesus says in the Gospel. And even more than that, they are, through their powerful intercession, holding the Church on their shoulders. We need contemplatives in the Church – Jesus still calls men and women to that life, to sit at His feet like Mary. And not only that, but every single person needs some time of silent prayer every single day – we too need to enter into contemplation. We need to learn how to pray what is called "mental prayer," a prayer of intimacy with the Lord God.

### Del Pastor, 20 Julio 2025

Existe una orden religiosa extraordinaria llamada los Cartujos, fundada hace unos 800 años por San Bruno. Son algunos de los monjes más intensos que tenemos en la Iglesia Católica, comprometiéndose a una vida de clausura con una comunidad interna muy limitada, mientras pasan la mayor parte de su tiempo en oración. Hay una película poderosa y hermosa llamada "El Gran Silencio" (Into Great Silence) que ofrece al espectador una mirada dentro del monasterio cartujo principal del mundo, llamado La Grande Chartreuse. Advertencia: dura 3 horas y prácticamente todo es silencio – ver la película es en sí mismo una experiencia contemplativa.

Desde un punto de vista secular, estos monjes parecen locos. ¿Por qué irse a las montañas y no hablar con nadie más, ni siquiera entre ellos? ¿Qué hacen todo el día? ¿Cuál es el sentido de todo eso? Pero desde nuestra perspectiva, sabemos que ellos han "elegido la mejor parte," como dice Jesús en el Evangelio. Y aún más: ellos, por medio de su poderosa intercesión, sostienen a la Iglesia sobre sus hombros. Necesitamos contemplativos en la Iglesia – Jesús todavía llama a hombres y mujeres a esa vida, a sentarse a sus pies como María.

Y no solo eso, sino que cada persona necesita un tiempo de oración en silencio todos los días – nosotros también necesitamos entrar en la contemplación. Necesitamos aprender a orar lo que se llama "oración mental," una oración de intimidad con el Señor Dios.

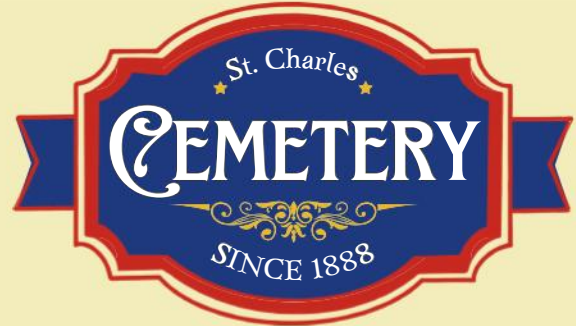

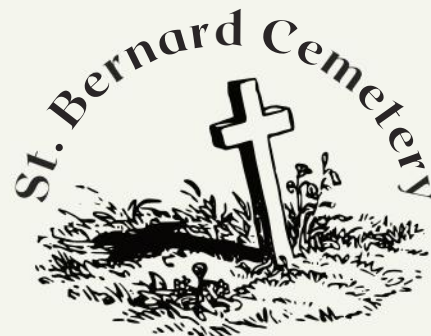
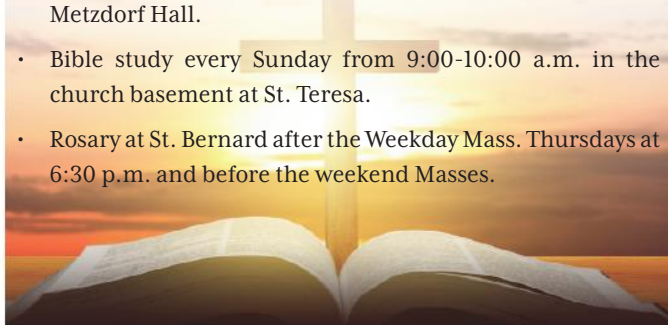

**Saint James**

*Saint of the Day: July 25 | Patron Saint of Laborers*

James was one of the favored three who had the privilege of witnessing the Transfiguration, the raising to life of the daughter of Jairus, and the agony in Gethsemani.

Two incidents in the Gospels describe the temperament of this man and his brother. Saint Matthew tells that their mother came – Mark says it was the brothers themselves – to ask that they have the seats of honor in the kingdom. “Jesus said in reply, ‘You do not know what you are asking. Can you drink the cup that I am going to drink?’ They said to him, ‘We can!’” (Matthew 20:22). Jesus then told them they would indeed drink the cup and share His baptism of pain and death, but that sitting at His right hand or left was not His to give – it “is for those for whom it has been prepared by my Father” (Matthew 20:23b). It remained to be seen how long it would take to realize the implications of their confident “We can!”

The other disciples became indignant at the ambition of James and John. Then Jesus taught them all the lesson of humble service: The purpose of authority is to serve. They are not to impose their will on others, or lord it over them. This is the position of Jesus Himself. He was the servant of all; the service imposed on Him was the supreme sacrifice of His own life.

James was apparently the first of the apostles to be martyred. “About that time King Herod laid hands upon some members of the church to harm them. He had James, the brother of John, killed by the sword, and when he saw that this was pleasing to the Jews he proceeded to arrest Peter also” (Acts 12:1-3a).

This James, sometimes called James the Greater, is not to be confused with James the Lesser or with the author of the Letter of James and the leader of the Jerusalem community.
