Unconditional surrender. This is what Jesus demands in the Gospel for today (Luke 14:25-33). “Anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple.” These are strong words – do we have the ears to hear them? As I have constantly said, it is so much easier not to be a Christian than to be a Christian, and this is one facet of it.

We live in a luxurious society and have many things. It is kind of like those bumper stickers that people sometimes have on their cars that imply that their dog or cat is in charge of their lives – do our possessions possess us? Do they own us, run our lives? This is a major obstacle for us if we are trying to be true and authentic Christians. As Jesus says in another place in the Gospel: “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be.” If the Lord God is our treasure, then we will end up with Him forever. If our treasure is something else, then we will not end up with Him forever. Let us accept the good God’s loving invitation to us; let us follow Jesus Christ closely as His disciples.

The biggest fear with a change in weekend Mass times seems to be that a church is closing. But, as you can see, from the schedule, every church has a weekend Mass. Many think that not having a weekend Mass is the closing of a church, but that is actually not the case. It may lead to it, but is not closing in itself. To say it plainly right now: no churches are closing. Even though we will become one parish soon, no churches are closing right now.

However, that is not to say that, sometime, possibly in the near future, we will decide to stop using some of our churches or properties and ask the Archbishop to close them. I spend a lot of time doing administration, as I hope you know, working hard to run this whole situation we call a Family of Parishes. And in running the numbers, I estimate that we probably have enough money to run 2 churches really well (hot take: we could actually all fit into one of our churches in Springfield) – or 5 churches in the way we have been running them. And, as we have already seen, the way things have always been done has not been working – our churches have been in steady and precipitous decline.

What if we envision a different future? What if we made sacrifices for the good of the whole, especially for the good of our young, who are no longer engaged in the church? What I envision is a real effort of religious outreach or evangelization which can transform not only our Catholic church in Clark County but also the whole of the county. This is possible, through the grace of God. All things are possible for God.

### Afrontando los miedos, Parte I

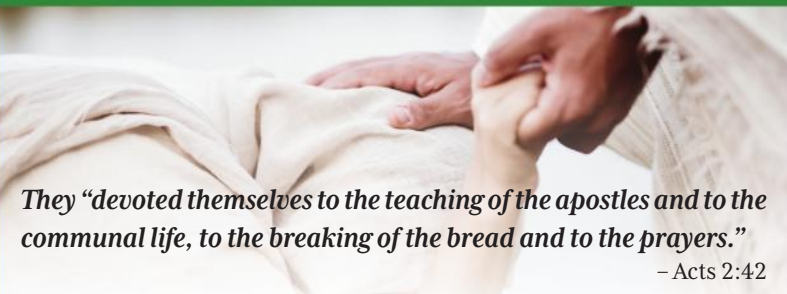

Y al revisar los números, estimo que probablemente tengamos suficiente dinero para manejar 2 iglesias realmente bien (dato contundente: en realidad todos podríamos caber en una de nuestras iglesias en Springfield) – o 5 iglesias de la manera en que las hemos estado manejando. Y, como ya hemos visto, la forma en que siempre se han hecho las cosas no ha estado funcionando – nuestras iglesias han estado en un declive constante y precipitado.

¿Qué pasaría si visualizamos un futuro diferente? ¿Qué pasaría si hiciéramos sacrificios por el bien del conjunto, especialmente por el bien de nuestros jóvenes, que ya no participan en la iglesia? Lo que yo imagino es un verdadero esfuerzo de alcance religioso o evangelización que pueda transformar no solo nuestra iglesia católica en el Condado de Clark sino también todo el condado. Esto es posible, por la gracia de Dios. Todas las cosas son posibles para Dios.
