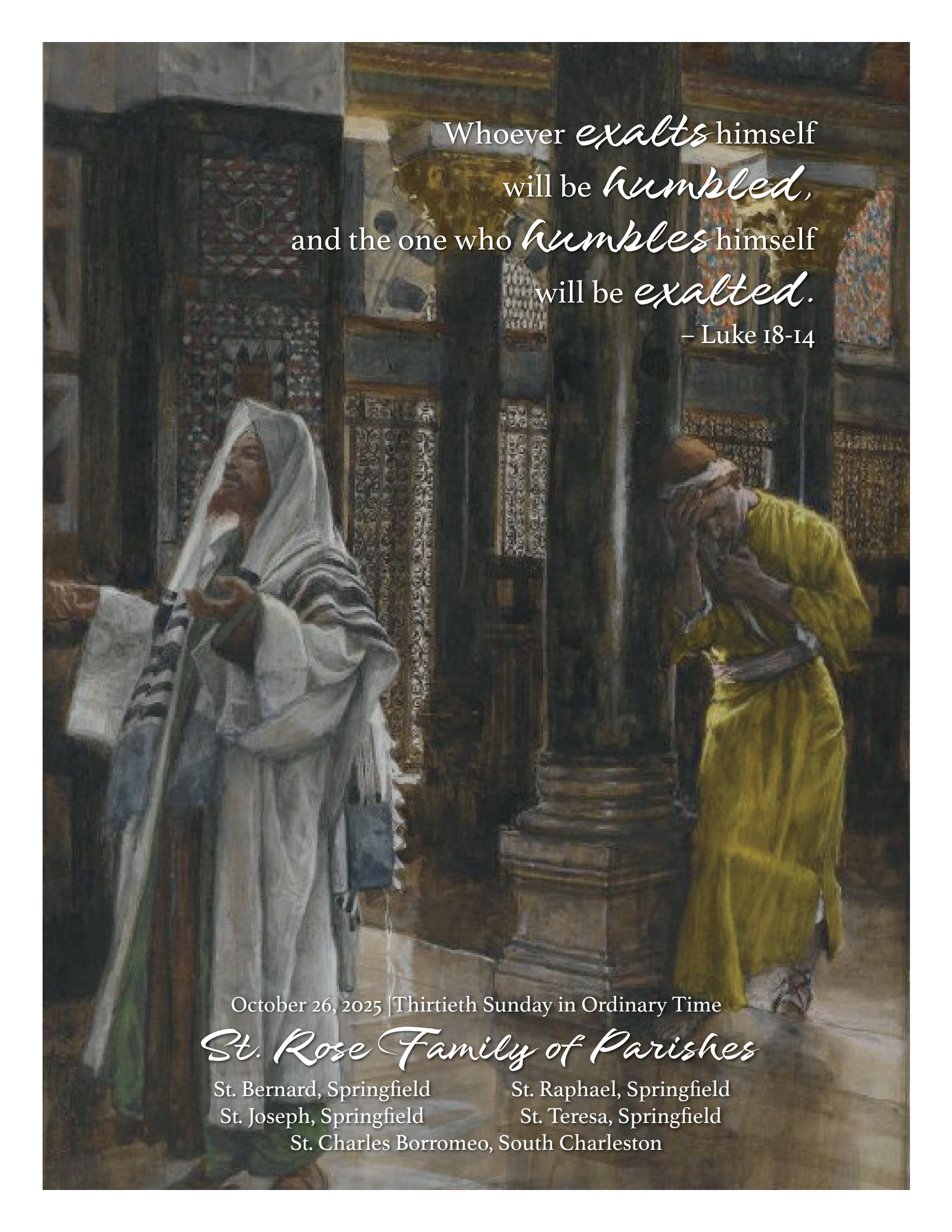

From the Pastor, October 26, 2025

In the Gospel for today (Luke 18:9-14), Jesus tells a parable which is just as pertinent today as it was the day that He first said it. I think that the way that we can encounter this parable is through the lens of the Sacrament of Confession. It has been my general observation that there are two ways to go to the Sacrament of Confession. The first is to go into Confession and say something like, “Well, I haven’t done anything really bad – other people really annoy me though, if they could stop doing that, then I would be a better person.” The second is to go in and humbly acknowledge the bare fact that we have wilfully done wrong and we need God’s forgiveness. These, of course, are exaggerations, not dissimilar from the story that Jesus told to make a point.

The lesson we can learn today is that we need to humbly approach the mercy of God and ask Him for forgiveness, not giving excuses. Our sins are our own fault. Owning up to them honestly and plainly is the proper way to approach the great Sacrament for the forgiveness of our sins that Jesus established, the Sacrament of Confession. Saints are made in the Sacrament of Confession. Let’s commit to going regularly to this source of mercy to receive what our hearts desire: healing for our sins.

En el Evangelio de hoy (Lucas 18, 9-14), Jesús cuenta una parábola que es tan relevante hoy como lo fue el día en que la pronunció por primera vez. Creo que podemos acercarnos a esta parábola a través del lente del Sacramento de la Confesión. He observado, en general, que hay dos maneras de acercarse a este sacramento. La primera es entrar al confesionario y decir algo como: “Bueno, no he hecho nada realmente malo... aunque otras personas me molestan mucho; si dejaran de hacerlo, yo sería una mejor persona.” La segunda manera es entrar con humildad y reconocer sencillamente que hemos hecho mal de manera voluntaria y que necesitamos el perdón de Dios. Estas, por supuesto, son exageraciones, no muy distintas de la historia que Jesús contó para dejar clara su enseñanza.

La lección que podemos aprender hoy es que debemos acercarnos con humildad a la misericordia de Dios y pedirle perdón, sin excusas. Nuestros pecados son culpa nuestra. Reconocerlos con honestidad y sencillez es la manera correcta de acercarnos a este gran sacramento que Jesús instituyó para el perdón de nuestros pecados: el Sacramento de la Confesión. Los santos se forjan en el Sacramento de la Confesión. Comprometámonos a acudir con regularidad a esta fuente de misericordia para recibir aquello que nuestro corazón más anhela: la sanación de nuestros pecados.

Commemoration of All The Faithful Departed All Souls' Day

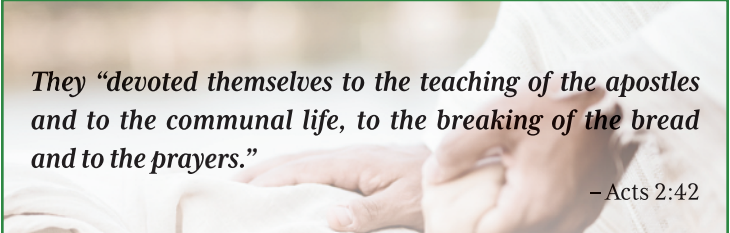
At the Masses on the weekend of November 1st and 2nd, All Souls' Day will be observed.

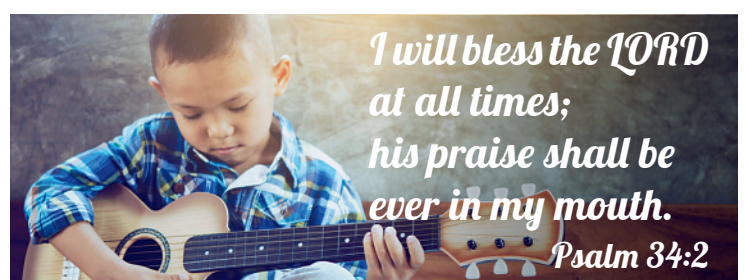
Each of our five parishes are represented on the double-sided "Our Father" beads. There are a variety of colors and styles.

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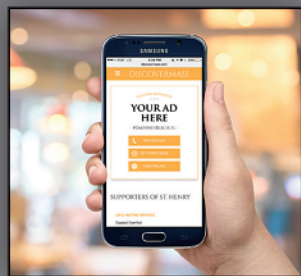


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
