

Vicar's Corner

From the Vicar, November 23, 2025

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe! The good thief, traditionally known as St. Dismas, asks in the Gospel, "Have you no fear of God?" What a powerful question to reflect on as we prepare to enter into the season of Advent. Growing up, I thought the Fear of the Lord – a gift of the Holy Spirit – meant being afraid of Him. This is not the case, however; it is to have a profound respect for God.

We all know that Christ is the King of the Universe, and yet the one thing He is not the king of—without permission—is our heart. As we go to Mass week in and week out, it can become very routine. We know when to sit, stand, sit, stand, and kneel. Unfortunately, when we get comfortable with our participation at Mass, we can miss what we are actually doing there. The Mass is a time to give the praise and worship that are due to God! And in God's infinite love for us, He gives us so much more in return – the Eucharist!

The Eucharist is such a powerful and wonderful gift from the Lord, and yet, when we receive Holy Communion, it can easily get lost among the other actions of the Mass. Jesus Christ wants to be the King of our hearts, and how wonderful it is that He is physically united to us when we receive the Blessed Sacrament!

As we celebrate The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, I invite you to reflect and enter even more deeply into what we receive at Mass, and to continue to deepen our relationship with God and our Fear of the Lord this Advent season. If you don't know where to start, here are a few tips you can try:

- 1. Before Mass begins, start in silent prayer, asking God to help you stay focused during the Mass.
- 2. As you are coming up in line to receive the Eucharist, silently repeat in your mind, "Jesus, I love you."
- 3. During the time of sacred silence after Communion, simply thank God for this wonderful gift He has given us.

As we continue to grow in love with our Lord, especially in the Eucharist, He will tear down the walls and barriers that we have put up in our hearts. What are you waiting for?

¡Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo!

El buen ladrón, tradicionalmente conocido como San Dimas, pregunta en el Evangelio: "¿No temes a Dios?" ¡Qué pregunta tan poderosa para reflexionar mientras nos preparamos para entrar en el tiempo de Adviento! De niño, yo pensaba que el Temor del Señor —un don del Espíritu Santo— significaba tenerle miedo a Dios. Sin embargo, no es así; se trata de tener un profundo respeto por Él. Todos sabemos que Cristo es el Rey del Universo, y sin embargo hay una sola cosa de la que Él no es rey – sin nuestro permiso – nuestro corazón. A medida que vamos a Misa semana tras semana, puede volverse algo rutinario. Sabemos cuándo sentarnos, ponernos de pie, sentarnos, ponernos de pie y arrodillarnos. Lamentablemente, cuando nos sentimos demasiado cómodos con nuestra participación en la Misa, podemos pasar por alto lo que realmente estamos haciendo allí. ¡La Misa es un momento para dar a Dios la alabanza y adoración que se le deben! Y en su amor infinito por nosotros, Él nos da muchísimo más a cambio: ¡la Eucaristía! La Eucaristía es un don tan poderoso y maravilloso del Señor, y sin embargo, cuando recibimos la Sagrada Comunión, fácilmente puede perderse entre las demás acciones de la Misa. Jesucristo quiere ser el Rey de nuestros corazones, ¡y qué maravilloso es que Él se una físicamente a nosotros cuando recibimos el Santísimo Sacramento!

Mientras celebramos la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo, te invito a reflexionar y entrar aún más profundamente en lo que recibimos en la Misa, y a continuar profundizando en nuestra relación con Dios y en nuestro Temor del Señor durante este tiempo de Adviento. Si no sabes por dónde empezar, aquí tienes algunos consejos que puedes intentar:

- 1. Antes de que comience la Misa, inicia con una oración en silencio, pidiéndole a Dios que te ayude a mantenerte enfocado durante la celebración.
- 2. Mientras te acercas en la fila para recibir la Eucaristía, repite en silencio en tu mente: "Jesús, te amo."
- 3. Durante el tiempo de silencio sagrado después de la Comunión, simplemente agradece a Dios por este maravilloso regalo que nos ha dado.

A medida que continuemos creciendo en el amor a nuestro Señor, especialmente en la Eucaristía, Él derribará los muros y barreras que hemos levantado en nuestro corazón. ¿Qué esperas?


