Vicar's Corner

From the Pastor, November 30, 2025

Happy new year, good people! Advent, as you remember, is the beginning of our new church year. Because we are Christians, we have a different axis around which we revolve. We consider time differently because we know that time is a creation of the loving God and we mark it in ways to honor Him. Jesus Christ is our center point, everything revolves around Him. As is very poetically stated in the motto of the most intense monastic community we have, the Carthusians: “Stat crux dum volvitur orbis,” which is Latin for “The Cross is steady while the world turns.”

Advent is that time of preparation, of waiting for the coming of Jesus at Christmas. We prepare ourselves through the Confession of our sins (we do not want to come to the King with stains upon us) and through diligent prayer. Our walk through Advent should be a gradual climbing of the mountain, like the one described in the first reading from the Prophet Isaiah. Let us be “instructed” by the word of the Lord which comes to us during this season and be transformed by that word.

¡Feliz Año Nuevo, buena gente! El Adviento, como recordarán, es el comienzo de nuestro nuevo año litúrgico. Como somos cristianos, tenemos un eje distinto alrededor del cual giramos. Consideramos el tiempo de manera diferente porque sabemos que el tiempo es una creación del Dios amoroso y lo marcamos de maneras que lo honran a Él. Jesucristo es nuestro punto central; todo gira en torno a Él. Como se expresa muy poéticamente en el lema de la comunidad monástica más intensa que tenemos, los cartujos: “Stat crux dum volvitur orbis,” que en latín significa: “La Cruz permanece firme mientras el mundo gira.”

El Adviento es ese tiempo de preparación, de espera por la venida de Jesús en Navidad. Nos preparamos mediante la confesión de nuestros pecados (no queremos presentarnos ante el Rey con manchas sobre nosotros) y mediante la oración diligente. Nuestro caminar por el Adviento debe ser una ascensión gradual de la montaña, como la que se describe en la primera lectura del profeta Isaías. Permitamos que la palabra del Señor que nos llega durante este tiempo nos “instruya” y que seamos transformados por esa palabra.

### Saint Francis Xavier

Saint of the Day: December 3

Patron Saint of Japan and Jewelers

Jesus asked, "What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" (Matthew 16:26a). The words were repeated to a young teacher of philosophy who had a highly promising career in academics, with success and a life of prestige and honor before him.

Francis Xavier, 24 at the time, and living and teaching in Paris, did not heed these words at once. They came from a good friend, Ignatius of Loyola, whose tireless persuasion finally won the young man to Christ. Francis then made the spiritual exercises under the direction of Ignatius, and in 1534, joined his little community, the infant Society of Jesus. Together at Montmartre they vowed poverty, chastity, obedience, and apostolic service according to the directions of the pope.

From Venice, where he was ordained a priest in 1537, Xavier went on to Lisbon and from there sailed to the East Indies, landing at Goa, on the west coast of India. For the next 10 years, he labored to bring the faith to such widely scattered peoples as the Hindus, the Malayans, and the Japanese. He spent much of that time in India, and served as provincial of the newly established Jesuit province of India.

Wherever he went, Xavier lived with the poorest people, sharing their food and rough accommodations. He spent countless hours ministering to the sick and the poor, particularly to lepers. Very often he had no time to sleep or even to say his breviary but, as we know from his letters, he was filled always with joy.

Xavier went through the islands of Malaysia, then up to Japan. He learned enough Japanese to preach to simple folk, to instruct, and to baptize, and to establish missions for those who were to follow him. From Japan he had dreams of going to China, but this plan was never realized. Before reaching the mainland, he died. His remains are enshrined in the Church of Good Jesus in Goa. He and Saint Thérèse of Lisieux were declared co-patrons of the missions in 1925.

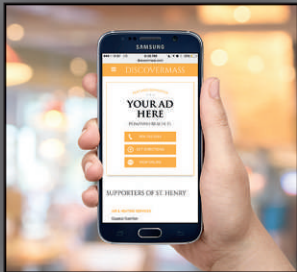
