## Pastor's Corner

### From the Pastor, December 7, 2025

St. John the Baptist is a strange bird, there's no doubt about it. His presence as the forerunner of Jesus is kind of like the trumpet that announces the presence of the King – at least that is how it is when kings are shown in the cartoons. The trumpet is clearly an announcement of some kind, but it also has another purpose. It is so loud that I think it may be to wake people up as well. And St. John the Baptist is definitely doing that, speaking in such a way that would really get the blood flowing. His words to the Sadducees and Pharisees in today's Gospel (Mt 3:1-12) would likely make them rather angry.

But the thing that should wake us up more is found before that – “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!” This can also be translated as “has drawn near” or even as “has arrived.” We can feel the urgency here – the trumpet announces the king's arrival and that we should begin preparations right now, not that we should leisurely begin our preparations after we have finished our lunch and taken a nap, and then start thinking about it. As our Advent preparation for Christmas continues, we can receive St. John the Baptist's trumpet call and be spurred on with greater urgency to prepare the way of the Lord.

### Del Párroco, 7 de Diciembre de 2025

San Juan Bautista es un personaje extraño, no hay duda de ello. Su presencia como el precursor de Jesús es como la trompeta que anuncia la llegada del Rey – al menos así es como aparecen los reyes en las caricaturas. La trompeta es claramente un anuncio de algún tipo, pero también tiene otro propósito. Es tan fuerte que creo que también sirve para despertar a la gente. Y San Juan Bautista definitivamente hace eso, hablando de una manera que realmente hace que la sangre circule. Sus palabras a los saduceos y fariseos en el Evangelio de hoy (Mt 3, 1-12) probablemente los habrían puesto bastante enojados.

Pero lo que debería despertarnos aún más se encuentra antes de eso: “¡Arrepiéntanse, porque el Reino de los Cielos está cerca!” Esto también puede traducirse como “se ha acercado” o incluso “ha llegado.” Aquí podemos sentir la urgencia: la trompeta anuncia la llegada del Rey y que debemos comenzar los preparativos ahora mismo, no que debamos comenzar tranquilamente después de terminar el almuerzo, tomar una siesta y luego empezar a pensar en ello. A medida que continúa nuestra preparación de Adviento para la Navidad, podemos recibir el toque de trompeta de San Juan Bautista y dejarnos impulsar con una mayor urgencia para preparar el camino del Señor.

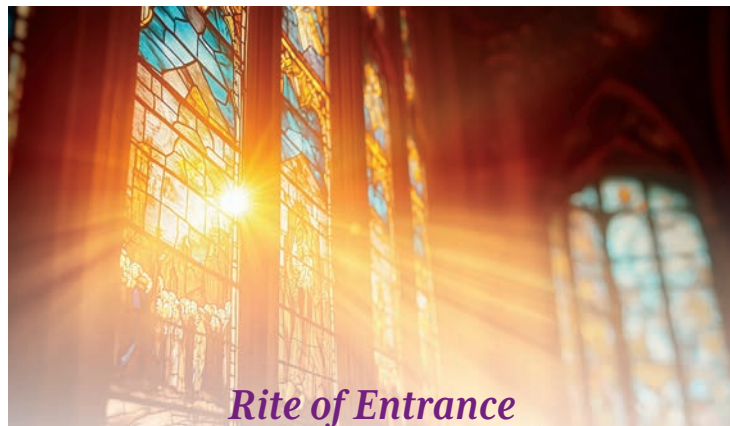


## St. Rose Family of Rosary Makers



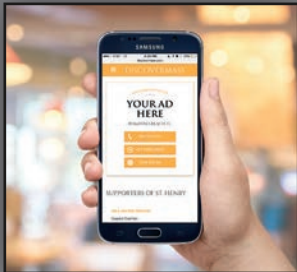
