Pastor's Corner

From the Pastor, January 25, 2026

It had been popular in previous years for people to call themselves Catholic with some kind of adjective before it. "I am a ____ Catholic," inserting various labels like liberal, conservative, traditional, social justice, Jesuit, and so on. I don't know if people do this nowadays, I haven't been paying a lot of attention. But the practice is problematic, and even we have an effort by St. Paul to address that problem in one of his letters to the Corinthians. "Is Christ divided?" he asks – the implied answer is a firm no.

We must be attached to Christ as our first and most important foundation. We should not label ourselves or others based upon real or perceived political associations. We should not overemphasize one part of the Gospel to the detriment of the other parts. We should, instead, remember that we are all attached to the Body of Christ. We are not the same – just as all the members of a human body are different – a hand is not a foot is not an ear – but we should not divide ourselves into camps. Let us ponder on St. Paul's words: Let "there be no divisions among you...be united in the same mind and in the same purpose." In my opinion we should use a single adjective to describe our Catholicism, which is Roman, which shows our unity with the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church which Jesus established and that He gave us a visible sign of unity, the Holy Father in Rome.

Del Pastor, 25 de Enero de 2026

En años anteriores, era común que la gente se llamara católica con algún adjetivo antes. "Soy un católico ____", insertando diversas etiquetas como liberal, conservador, tradicionalista, defensor de la justicia social, jesuita, etc. No sé si la gente lo hace hoy en día; no he estado prestando mucha atención. Pero la práctica es problemática, e incluso nosotros tenemos un intento de San Pablo por abordar ese problema en una de sus cartas a los Corintios. "¿Está dividido Cristo?", pregunta; la respuesta implícita es un rotundo no.

Debemos estar unidos a Cristo como nuestro primer y más importante fundamento. No debemos etiquetarnos a nosotros mismos ni a los demás basándonos en asociaciones políticas, reales o percibidas. No debemos sobreenfatizar una parte del Evangelio en detrimento de las demás. En cambio, debemos recordar que todos estamos unidos al Cuerpo de Cristo. No somos iguales, así como todos los miembros del cuerpo humano son diferentes (una mano no es un pie ni una oreja), pero no debemos dividirnos en bandos. Reflexionemos en las palabras de San Pablo: "Que no haya divisiones entre ustedes... estén unidos en un mismo sentir y en un mismo propósito". En mi opinión, deberíamos usar un solo adjetivo para describir nuestro catolicismo: romano, que muestra nuestra unidad con la Iglesia una, santa, católica y apostólica que Jesús estableció y de la que nos dio un signo visible de unidad: el Santo Padre en Roma.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

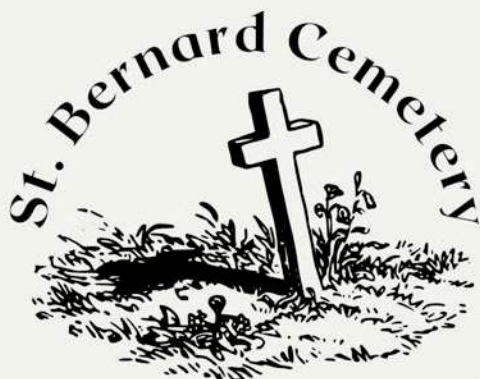


One of the things that is regularly asked of our priests is for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. This is a Sacrament established by Jesus for the consolation of those "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age" (Canon Law 1004). The effects of the Sacrament are beautiful – it gives comfort in suffering and courage to overcome the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. It can lead to physical healing, forgiveness of sins, and assists in preparing for passing into eternal life.

Because of the greatness of this Sacrament, our desire to serve our people well, and the frenetic pace of serving five parishes at one time, Fr. Komo and Fr. Hale have decided to only receive requests for the Anointing of the Sick through an online form. This is to assist us in serving you better for many reasons. It, first, ensures that our priests are contacted in a timely manner. Once the form is completed, a notification is sent immediately to our priests. Second, it provides us with the information we need to serve our people well. Third, it removes confusion about how to contact a priest, which has been a significant barrier in the past.

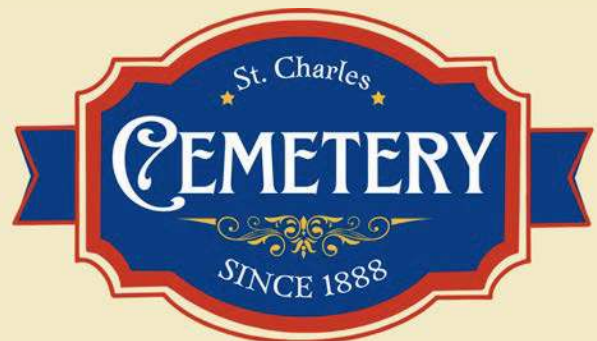
We should remember that we should not wait until the point of death to call for a priest. As it says in our Catechism #1512: "It is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived." It is important that we are accompanied through the "ordinary means of sanctification" which Jesus has given us, especially this wonderful Sacrament of healing!

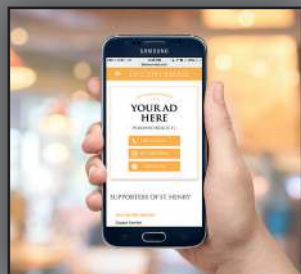
