## Pastor's Corner

### From the Pastor, February 1, 2026

There are many deep questions which are fundamental to human existence. "Who am I?" "Where did I come from?" "How do I best pursue happiness?" These are constantly with us and formulating answers to these questions is part of development as a human being. St. Augustine, in an exploration of the Sermon on the Mount, makes the claim that "the Beatitudes give us Christ's answer to the primary human question about happiness..." (The Sources of Christian Ethics, Servais Pinckaers, O.P., p. 149). And we hear the Beatitudes today in our Gospel, those extraordinary statements from Jesus which open the Sermon on the Mount.

If what St. Augustine says is true, then we must seek within the Beatitudes and the Sermon on the Mount that follows for answers. What Jesus does make clear later is that there is a way to live, a moral way of living which brings happiness. How we act matters. How we treat each other matters. One pressing matter in our community concerns immigration – the Temporary Protected Status of our Haitian neighbors has been revoked beginning on February 3, 2026. In closing, I will simply quote part of a statement from the United States bishops, though I encourage you to read the whole of their statement, which they made on November 12, 2025 and which I wholly endorse.

"To our immigrant brothers and sisters, we stand with you in your suffering, since, when one member suffers, all suffer (cf. 1 Corinthians 12:26). You are not alone!

"We note with gratitude that so many of our clergy, consecrated religious, and lay faithful already accompany and assist immigrants in meeting their basic human needs. We urge all people of good will to continue and expand such efforts.

"We oppose the indiscriminate mass deportation of people. We pray for an end to dehumanizing rhetoric and violence, whether directed at immigrants or at law enforcement. We pray that the Lord may guide the leaders of our nation, and we are grateful for past and present opportunities to dialogue with public and elected officials. In this dialogue, we will continue to advocate for meaningful immigration reform."

### Del Pastor, 1 de Febrero de 2026

Existen muchas preguntas profundas que son fundamentales para la existencia humana. "¿Quién soy?" "¿De dónde vengo?" "¿Cuál es la mejor manera de buscar la felicidad?" Estas preguntas nos acompañan constantemente, y formular respuestas a ellas forma parte del desarrollo humano. San Agustín, al analizar el Sermón de la Montaña, afirma que «las Bienaventuranzas nos dan la respuesta de Cristo a la pregunta fundamental del ser humano sobre la felicidad...» (Las fuentes de la ética cristiana, Servais Pinckaers, O.P., p. 149). Y hoy escuchamos las Bienaventuranzas en nuestro Evangelio, esas extraordinarias declaraciones de Jesús que abren el Sermón de la Montaña.

Si lo que dice San Agustín es cierto, entonces debemos buscar respuestas en las Bienaventuranzas y el Sermón de la Montaña que sigue. Lo que Jesús aclara más adelante es que hay una manera de vivir, una forma moral de vivir que trae felicidad. Nuestra forma de actuar importa. Nuestra forma de tratarnos unos a otros importa. Un asunto urgente en nuestra comunidad se refiere a la inmigración: el Estatus de Protección Temporal de nuestros vecinos haitianos ha sido revocado a partir del 3 de febrero de 2026. Para concluir, simplemente citaré parte de una declaración de los obispos de Estados Unidos, aunque los animo a leerla completa, la cual emitieron el 12 de noviembre de 2025 y que apoyo plenamente.

A nuestros hermanos y hermanas inmigrantes, los acompañamos en su sufrimiento, pues, cuando un miembro sufre, todos sufren (cf. 1 Corintios 12:26). ¡No están solos!

Observamos con gratitud que tantos clérigos, religiosos consagrados y fieles laicos ya acompañan y asisten a los inmigrantes en la satisfacción de sus necesidades humanas básicas. Instamos a todas las personas de buena voluntad a continuar y ampliar estos esfuerzos.

Nos oponemos a la deportación masiva indiscriminada de personas. Oramos por el fin de la retórica deshumanizante y la violencia, ya sea dirigida contra los inmigrantes o contra las fuerzas del orden. Oramos para que el Señor guíe a los líderes de nuestra nación y agradecemos las oportunidades pasadas y presentes de dialogar con funcionarios públicos y electos. En este diálogo, seguiremos abogando por una reforma migratoria significativa.






