**Pastor's Corner**

**From the Pastor, February 8, 2026**

I am always leaving the lights on. That's probably a bad thing, a bad habit that, if I tried, it would be hard to break. I've lived with people who got sick of following me around and turning the lights off after me. While lights don't have feelings, what if we anthropomorphized them a little and gave them some feelings? The lights that I leave on in the house probably would get tired, worn out, and feel that their light is being misused because I am only in the room a small percentage of the time.

I am talking about lights because Jesus talks about light in the Gospel (Mt. 5:13-16). "You are the light of the world," He says. And maybe we too get tired, worn out, and feel like no one is taking advantage of the light. His words, however, should encourage us to continue to live brightly as joy-filled Christians. To be a Christian means to give off light, no matter what. Being a Christian is like having a chemical reaction which necessarily gives off light – what happens to that light? Who knows—we do not control that, but we trust that, in God's providence, it is being used well.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy New Year! I pray that you had a blessed and joyful Christmas season with your family, friends, and loved ones.

A new year calls us to reflection. As we look back with gratitude for God's goodness, we look ahead with faith and hope. Even amidst life's daily challenges, we have so much to thank God for. We also have so much to look forward to. We live in hope, recognizing the love of Christ that has been handed on from generation to generation is now our responsibility to reveal, to share, and to radiate more fully. This has been at the heart of our local Church's efforts with Beacons of Light.

Beacons of Light has assisted us in discerning how we might fully live our Catholic faith in this particular time and place. I am grateful to the commitment of so many who have taken up the challenge of Beacons of Light to move our Church from maintenance to mission and more clearly radiate Christ's love throughout the 19 counties of our archdiocese. As the phases of Beacons of Light come to conclusion between now and June 2027, each Family of Parishes will continue this effort by engaging in discernment of the best use of its resources – its buildings, finances, and personnel.

We must keep in mind that Beacons of Light has not been a typical process or program; we have been given a mandate to take up the mission and ministry of Christ in our present day. We ensure that it will continue for years to come through the six foundational principles of vitality and missionary discipleship. How we transition from the phases of Beacons of Light into the ongoing work of our parishes, schools, and institutions becomes the question.

After much prayer and consultation on this question, I have decided that we will conduct an archdiocesan synod over the next two years. Since our last archdiocesan synod in 1971, much has changed in our Church. A diocesan synod at this time will offer us a moment where we can prayerfully listen to the Holy Spirit and to one another in order to discover anew the joy of our discipleship. It will culminate with a general assembly where representatives of our clergy, religious, and laity will join together to discuss how Christ seeks to shepherd us into the future.

Inspired by the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, encouraged by Pope Leo's efforts to create a more synodal Church, and considering the more than fifty years that have passed since our last synod was held, **Synod 2027** will offer our local Church a blessed opportunity to recognize Christ in our midst and respond enthusiastically to His call. More details will be forthcoming this spring. In the meantime, information on **Synod 2027** can be found at [catholicaoc.org/synod2027](http://catholicaoc.org/synod2027). Please join me in prayer for the fruitfulness of our upcoming synod and for the wellbeing of all God's children in our archdiocese, especially those who may be suffering and seeking hope.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

¡Feliz año nuevo! Espero que hayan tenido una temporada navideña bendecida y alegre con sus familias, amigos y seres queridos.

Un nuevo año nos llama a la reflexión. Mientras miramos hacia atrás con gratitud por la bondad de Dios, miramos hacia adelante con fe y esperanza. Incluso en medio de los desafíos diarios de la vida, tenemos mucho que agradecer a Dios. También tenemos muchas cosas que esperar. Vivimos en la esperanza, reconociendo que el amor de Cristo que ha sido transmitido de generación en generación es ahora nuestra responsabilidad de revelar, compartir e irradiar más plenamente. Esto ha estado en el centro de los esfuerzos de nuestra Iglesia local con el proceso de Faros de Luz.

Faros de Luz nos ha ayudado a discernir cómo podemos vivir plenamente nuestra fe católica en este tiempo y lugar particular. Estoy agradecido por el compromiso de tantos que han asumido el desafío de Faros de Luz para llevar nuestra Iglesia del mantenimiento a la misión e irradiar más claramente el amor de Cristo en los 19 condados de nuestra arquidiócesis. A medida que las fases de Faros de Luz llegan a su fin entre ahora y junio de 2027, cada Familia de Parroquias continuará este esfuerzo participando en el discernimiento del mejor uso de sus recursos: sus edificios, finanzas y personal.

Debemos tener presente que Faros de Luz no ha sido un proceso o programa típico; se nos ha dado un mandato de asumir la misión y el ministerio de Cristo en nuestros días. Nos aseguramos de que esto continúe durante los próximos años a través de los seis principios fundamentales de vitalidad y discipulado misionero. La pregunta es cómo pasamos de las fases de Faros de Luz al trabajo continuo de nuestras parroquias, escuelas e instituciones.

Después de mucha oración y consulta sobre esta cuestión, he decidido que celebraremos un sínodo arquidiocesano durante los próximos dos años. Desde nuestro último sínodo arquidiocesano en 1971, mucho ha cambiado en nuestra Iglesia. Un sínodo diocesano en este momento nos ofrecerá un momento en el que podremos escuchar en oración al Espíritu Santo y a los demás, y así descubrir de nuevo la alegría de nuestro discipulado. El sínodo culminará con una asamblea general donde representantes de nuestro clero, religiosos y laicos se reunirán para conversar sobre cómo Cristo busca pastorearnos hacia el futuro.

Inspirados por la historia de los discípulos en el camino de Emaús, animados por los esfuerzos del Papa León por crear una Iglesia más sinodal, y considerando los más de cincuenta años que han pasado desde que se celebró nuestro último sínodo, el **Sínodo 2027** ofrecerá a nuestra Iglesia local una oportunidad de bendición en reconocer a Cristo en medio de nosotros y responder con entusiasmo a su llamado. Se darán a conocer más detalles esta primavera. Mientras tanto, información sobre el **Sínodo 2027** se puede encontrar en [catholicaoc.org/synod2027](http://catholicaoc.org/synod2027). Únanse a mí en oración para que se den muchos frutos durante nuestro sínodo que se aproxima y por el bienestar de todos los hijos de Dios en nuestra arquidiócesis, especialmente aquellos que pueden estar sufriendo y buscando esperanza.


