

From the Pastor, March 15, 2026

I was recently in a Q/A session with Fr. Hale and some of our young people who are seeking confirmation. There were a lot of questions, some light, some more weighty. And one of the questions was about music at Mass and our preferences. People feel really strongly about music at Mass, I have found. For myself, I do my absolute best to be formed in the mind of the Church. We should be true sons and daughters of the Church and formed by Her. One of the beautiful traditions that has developed organically in the Church has been Gregorian chant and the Second Vatican Council says that chant is to be preferred above all other music. As it says in the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (Sacrosanctum Concilium): “The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.”

I think of Gregorian chant today because the name of our celebration today is taken from the first word of the Gregorian chant introit (entrance antiphon) for this Mass: “Laetare,” which is a command to rejoice. In the middle of Lent, perhaps we have gotten tired in our forty-day journey in the desert with Jesus and so the Church, in Her wisdom, provides a reminder to keep the faith, to be encouraged, because we know the joy that awaits us at the culmination of our journey: the Resurrection of Jesus, the promise that we, too, even now share in His life when we receive His grace and live as true sons and daughters of God.

Del Pastor, 15 de Marzo de 2026

Recientemente estuve en una sesión de preguntas y respuestas con el Padre Hale y algunos de nuestros jóvenes que buscan la confirmación. Hubo muchas preguntas, algunas superficiales, otras más profundas. Una de ellas fue sobre la música en la misa y nuestras preferencias. He descubierto que la gente tiene una opinión muy firme sobre la música en la misa. Por mi parte, hago todo lo posible por formarme en la mentalidad de la Iglesia. Debemos ser verdaderos hijos e hijas de la Iglesia y ser formados por Ella. Una de las hermosas tradiciones que se ha desarrollado orgánicamente en la Iglesia ha sido el canto gregoriano, y el Concilio Vaticano II afirma que el canto debe preferirse a cualquier otra música. Como dice la Constitución sobre la Sagrada Liturgia (Sacrosanctum Concilium): “La Iglesia reconoce el canto gregoriano como especialmente adecuado para la liturgia romana; por lo tanto, en igualdad de condiciones, debe otorgársele un lugar privilegiado en los servicios litúrgicos”.

Pienso hoy en el canto gregoriano porque el nombre de nuestra celebración proviene de la primera palabra del introito (antífona de entrada) del canto gregoriano para esta misa: “Laetare”, que es un mandato a la alegría. En plena Cuaresma, quizás nos hemos cansado de nuestro peregrinar de cuarenta días por el desierto con Jesús, y por eso la Iglesia, en su sabiduría, nos recuerda que debemos mantener la fe y sentirnos animados, porque conocemos la alegría que nos espera al culminar nuestro camino: la Resurrección de Jesús, la promesa de que también nosotros, incluso ahora, compartimos su vida cuando recibimos su gracia y vivimos como verdaderos hijos e hijas de Dios.



Followed by celebration of the candidates

The Rite of Reception is where those who have been baptized as Christians in another denomination are brought into full communion with the Catholic Church by making a Profession of Faith. After the Profession of Faith, they will receive Confirmation, and for the first time be invited to the table of the Lord (thus receiving their first Eucharist).

Why not Easter Vigil?
The Church encourages us to separate those who have already begun their Christian journey (i.e. the baptized) from those who are beginning their Christian journey (i.e. catechumens). To show the dignity of baptism, the Church recognizes the difference between the baptized and unbaptized, hence the Rite of Reception and the Easter Vigil being separate liturgies. 
