From the Pastor, March 22, 2026

The miracle that occurs in today’s Gospel of the raising of Lazarus from the dead (found in St. John’s Gospel, 11:1-45) is the greatest miracle that Jesus performs. On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, which historically has also been called First Passion Sunday, we are reminded of the greatness of the Resurrection, which is an even greater event than the raising of Lazarus from the dead. Because Lazarus would die again – in a strange turn of events, the Gospel records that there are some who are trying to kill him so he dies a second time! The Resurrection is greater than this, however – it is the way that Jesus has chosen to open the way to heaven for us, inviting us to live our lives with Him now so that we might be with Him in heaven. This reminds me of our “why we exist” statement: To know, love, and serve God, and to make His love known to others. Our parishes exist for this purpose, so we might be faithful disciples of Jesus and help others to become faithful disciples.

As the high feast of the whole year approaches, those who are preparing to become Catholic are in the final stage of their preparation. I strongly encourage you to come out to the initiation of our candidates, which will take place at St. Joseph at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 25. We will have the initiation of catechumens at the Easter Vigil as usual, but on our solemn celebration of the Incarnation of the Lord on March 25 (also called the feast of the Annunciation of the Lord), we will initiate those already baptized. Come and support those who are striving to follow Jesus more closely by becoming Catholic!

El milagro de la resurrección de Lázaro, narrado en el Evangelio de San Juan 11:1-45, es el mayor milagro que Jesús realiza. En este quinto domingo de Cuaresma, también conocido como el Primer Domingo de la Pasión, recordamos la grandeza de la Resurrección, un acontecimiento aún mayor que la resurrección de Lázaro. Lázaro moriría de nuevo; en un giro inesperado de los acontecimientos, el Evangelio relata que algunos intentaban matarlo para que muriera por segunda vez. Sin embargo, la Resurrección es aún mayor: es el camino que Jesús eligió para abrirnos el camino al cielo, invitándonos a vivir con Él ahora para poder estar con Él en el cielo. Esto me recuerda nuestra razón de ser: conocer, amar y servir a Dios, y dar a conocer su amor a los demás. Nuestras parroquias existen con este propósito: ser discípulos fieles de Jesús y ayudar a otros a serlo también.

A medida que se acerca la fiesta más importante del año, quienes se preparan para convertirse al catolicismo se encuentran en la etapa final de su preparación. Los invito a asistir a la iniciación de nuestros candidatos, que tendrá lugar en la iglesia de San José a las 18:30 h del miércoles 25 de marzo. Como es habitual, la iniciación de los catecúmenos se realizará durante la Vigilia Pascual, pero en nuestra solemne celebración de la Encarnación del Señor el 25 de marzo (también conocida como la fiesta de la Anunciación del Señor), iniciaremos a quienes ya han sido bautizados. ¡Vengan y apoyen a quienes se esfuerzan por seguir a Jesús más de cerca al convertirse al catolicismo!

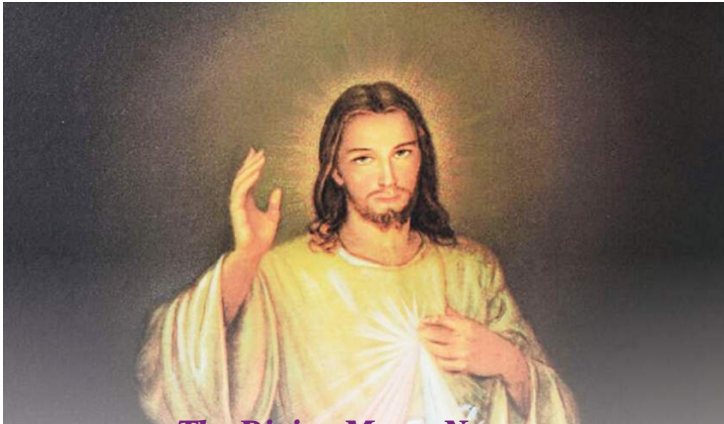



Followed by celebration of the candidates

The Rite of Reception is where those who have been baptized as Christians in another denomination are brought into full communion with the Catholic Church by making a Profession of Faith. After the Profession of Faith, they will receive Confirmation, and for the first time be invited to the table of the Lord (thus receiving their first Eucharist).

Why not Easter Vigil?
The Church encourages us to separate those who have already begun their Christian journey (i.e. the baptized) from those who are beginning their Christian journey (i.e. catechumens). To show the dignity of baptism, the Church recognizes the difference between the baptized and unbaptized, hence the Rite of Reception and the Easter Vigil being separate liturgies. 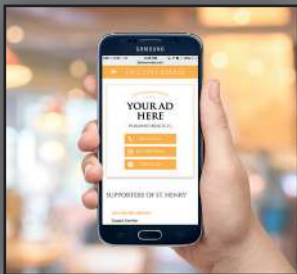
