*Our Lord said to St. Faustina:
Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you...
Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...
When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior.*

Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy. Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will. (687, 1541, 1731)

Altar of Repose (Night Watch)

After Holy Thursday Mass (~10:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m. Friday) at St. Teresa Church.

- Please enter through the doors by the elevator (it will remain open all night)

Please join our parish family as we sit and spend time with our Lord in imitation of The Apostles spending time with our Blessed Lord in the Garden of Gethsemane on the night of His agony. This is a time-honored tradition for the faithful to enter more fully to our Lord’s Passion, stretching back to at least the 16th century.

If you notice, the Mass doesn’t technically end on Holy Thursday, but this Liturgy of The Lord’s Supper thus begins the Holy Triduum connecting this night with Christ’s glorious Resurrection celebrated at the Easter Vigil after sundown on Holy Saturday.

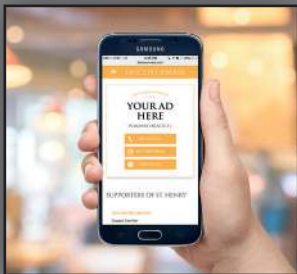
