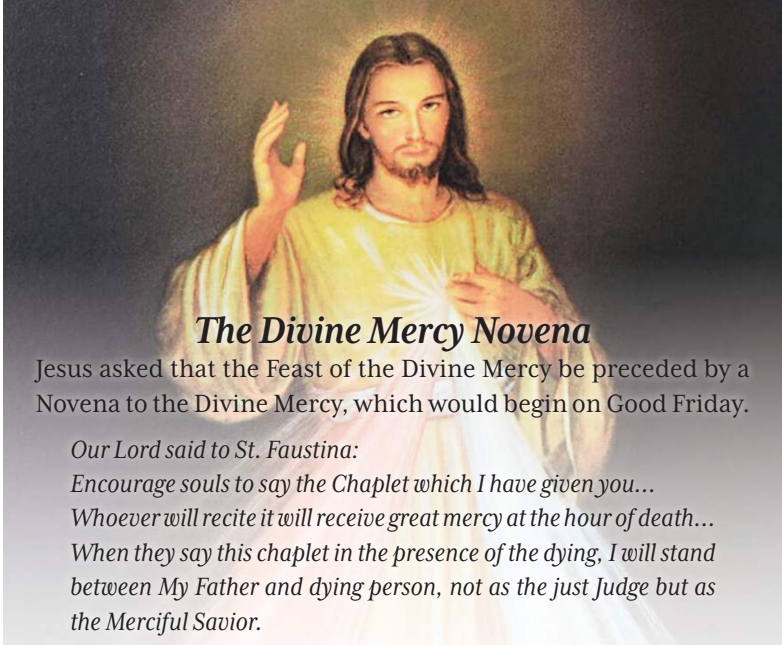
The Divine Mercy Chaplet

The Divine Mercy Novena

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy, which would begin on Good Friday.

*Our Lord said to St. Faustina:
Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you...
Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...
When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior.*

*Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation.
Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy. Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will. (687, 1541, 1731)*

The St. Rose Family rosary makers sent almost 3,000 rosaries to Our Lady's

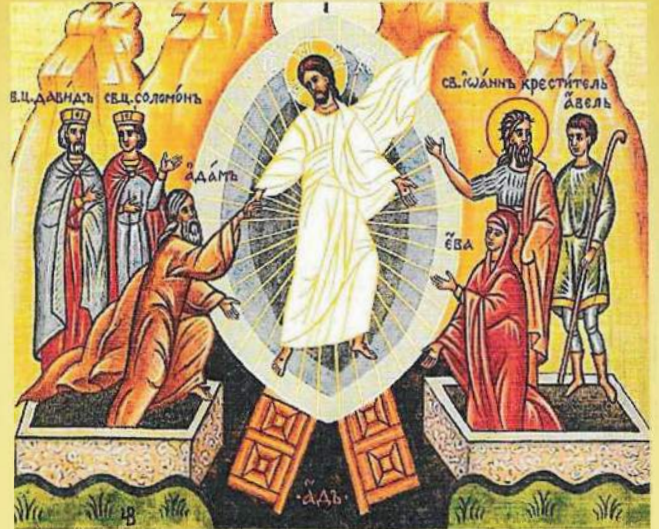
Rosary Makers last month. From there, they will go to missions all over the world requesting rosaries.

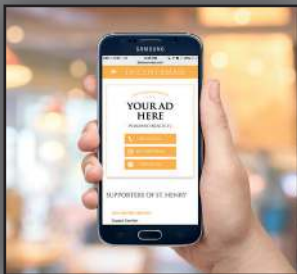
