Mercy

Reflection on John 20:19-31

I don't remember who said this, but it rings so true: Christianity has nothing to say to someone who does not know himself/herself to be a sinner. If I do not know and accept my need for forgiveness and redemption, then Divine Mercy makes no sense; it is lost on me.

How blessed and grateful we are, though, when this great gift of Divine Mercy is accepted, and flows into our hearts and lives! I am convinced that when we receive God's mercy, in a proper disposition of true repentance, then God does not want us to be burdened with the sins that have shamed us and brought us low. Instead, God desires us to be truly free, for His gift of mercy liberates us to be merciful.

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites Thomas into His wounds, and so into the reception of His divine life. This is the pattern of our lives as well. It is going deeply into our wounds which sin has caused, where we are in contact with the wounds of Christ which redeem us. Praise God for His great mercy!

En cambio, Dios desea que seamos verdaderamente libres, pues su don de misericordia nos libera para ser misericordiosos.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús invita a Tomás a entrar en sus heridas y, así, a recibir su vida divina. Este es también el modelo de nuestras vidas. Es adentrarnos profundamente en las heridas que el pecado ha causado, donde entramos en contacto con las heridas de Cristo que nos redimen. ¡Alabado sea Dios por su gran misericordia!

The Divine Mercy Novena

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy, which would begin on Good Friday.

Our Lord said to St. Faustina:
 Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you...
 Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...
 When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior.

Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy. Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will. (687, 1541, 1731)

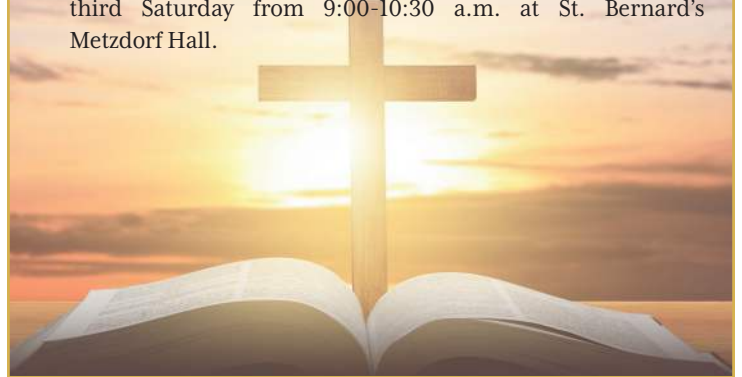

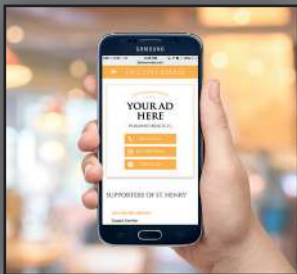
