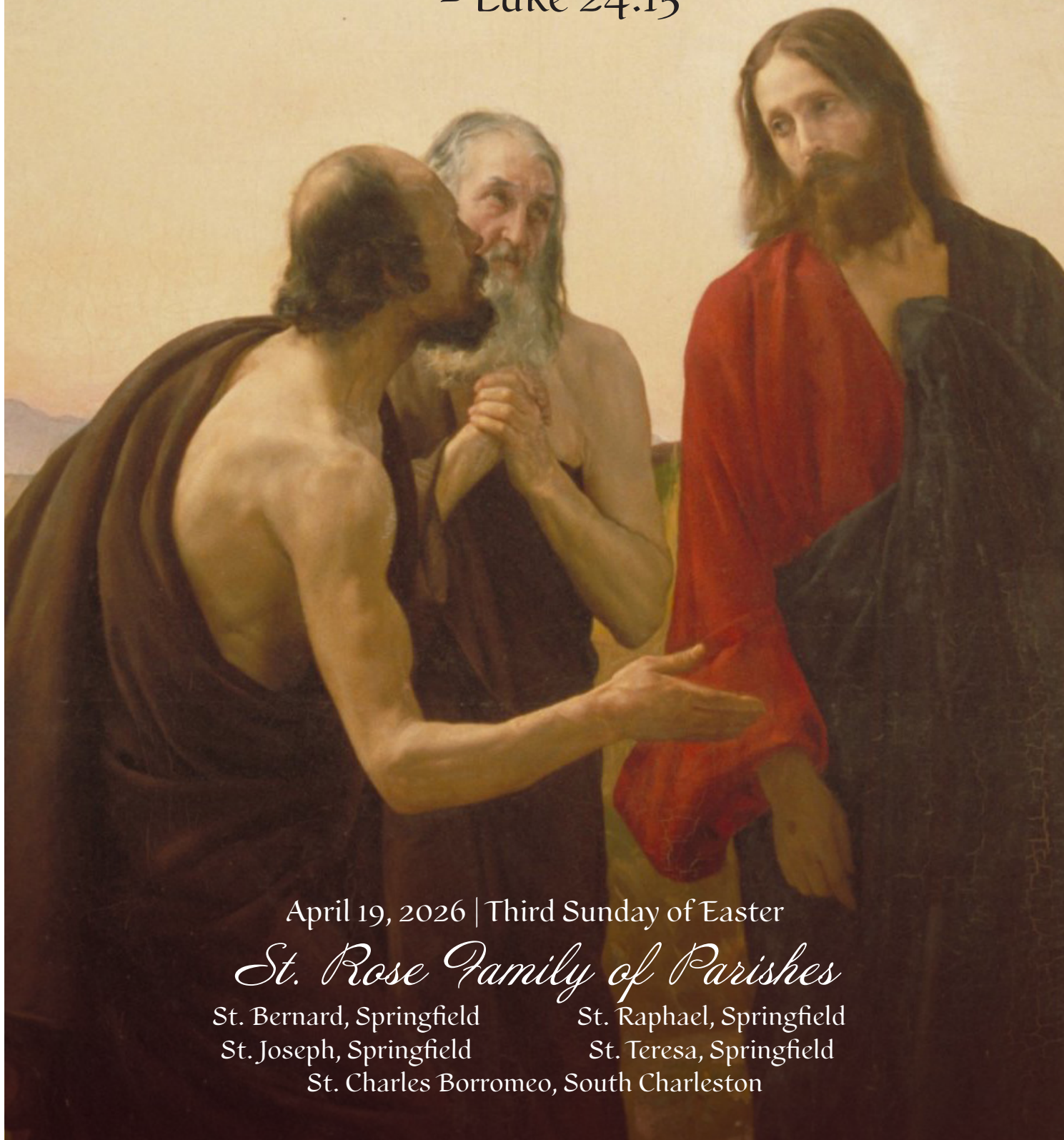

From the Pastor – April 19, 2026

As we read through the accounts of the disciples encountering the Resurrected Jesus, one thing that may strike us is how they do not recognize Him when they first see Him. They had spent a lot of time with Jesus. It had only been a few days since they had seen Him last. But, for some reason, they are prevented from recognizing Him in His resurrected Body. This happens to the two disciples, Cleopas and the other disciple, on the way to Emmaus, which we hear in the Gospel today (Luke 24:13-35).

What it was exactly that prevented them from recognizing Him, we do not know exactly. What we can say is that a new paradigm has been entered in which the old ways of thinking are no longer sufficient. The Resurrection has totally transformed the world and we cannot approach it as we had in the past. Even when we encounter Jesus now, perhaps we are just as confused as the two disciples. Perhaps it is only by looking backward and remarking that, yes, our hearts too were burning within us when we were in His presence.

Jesus is not present with us in the same way as He was in the Resurrection accounts. Instead, He has chosen a very concrete way to be with us in a hidden way: in the Eucharist. He is really, truly, and substantially present in the Eucharist and we can really meet Him there, as the two disciples did at that Mass in Emmaus.

Del Pastor – 19 de abril de 2026

Al leer los relatos del encuentro de los discípulos con Jesús resucitado, algo que puede llamarnos la atención es cómo no lo reconocen al verlo por primera vez. Habían pasado mucho tiempo con Jesús; apenas habían transcurrido unos días desde la última vez que lo vieron. Sin embargo, por alguna razón, no logran reconocerlo en su cuerpo resucitado. Esto les sucede a los dos discípulos, Cleofás y el otro, camino a Emaús, como se narra en el Evangelio de hoy (Lucas 24:13-35).

Desconocemos con exactitud qué les impidió reconocerlo. Lo que sí podemos afirmar es que se ha instaurado un nuevo paradigma en el que las antiguas formas de pensar ya no son suficientes. La Resurrección ha transformado por completo el mundo y no podemos abordarlo como antes. Incluso cuando nos encontramos con Jesús hoy, tal vez nos sintamos tan confundidos como los dos discípulos. Quizás solo al mirar hacia atrás y darnos cuenta de que, sí, nuestros corazones también ardían en su interior cuando estábamos en su presencia, lo entendemos.

Jesús no está presente con nosotros de la misma manera que en los relatos de la Resurrección. En cambio, ha elegido una forma muy concreta de estar con nosotros de manera discreta: en la Eucaristía. Está real, verdadera y sustancialmente presente en la Eucaristía, y podemos encontrarnos con él allí, como lo hicieron los dos discípulos en aquella misa de Emaús.

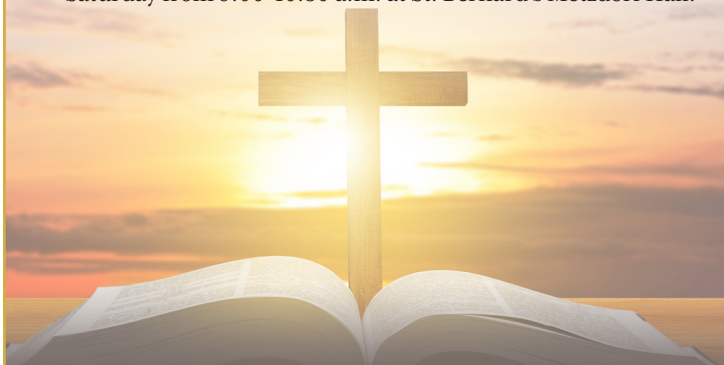

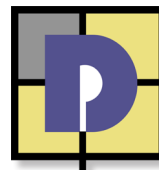
