From the Pastor

May 3, 2026

As we continue reflecting on that earth-shaking truth of the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead, we work our way through the record of the Early Church immediately after the Resurrection and Pentecost, as taken down by St. Luke in the Acts of the Apostles. We have an episode from this era from the 6th chapter in the first reading today – the recognition of the need for more servants of God to assist in the mission of the Church and the Spirit-led appointing of seven deacons. It was last weekend that we in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati had our ordination of deacons at St. Peter in Chains Cathedral Basilica.

What we must remember is that each of us, through our Baptism, are anointed with the same Holy Spirit and called to be evangelizers, servants of God. Each of us must play our unique role in bringing Jesus to others. As Pope Francis very directly states in *Evangelii Gaudium*: “All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization, and it would be insufficient to envisage a plan of evangelization to be carried out by professionals while the rest of the faithful would simply be passive recipients.” This is why we are launching an effort called “FIRE NIGHTS” to equip our parishioners with some simple direction in how to evangelize, led by the efforts of Nic Kovatch, our Director of Evangelization for the St. Rose Family of Parishes. I strongly encourage you to take part in this, so that together we might reach all of Clark County for Christ!

3 de mayo de 2026

Mientras seguimos reflexionando sobre la trascendental verdad de la Resurrección de Jesús, repasamos el relato de la Iglesia primitiva inmediatamente después de la Resurrección y Pentecostés, tal como lo recoge San Lucas en los Hechos de los Apóstoles. Hoy, en la primera lectura, tenemos un episodio de esta época que se encuentra en el capítulo 6: el reconocimiento de la necesidad de más siervos de Dios para ayudar en la misión de la Iglesia y el nombramiento, guiado por el Espíritu Santo, de siete diáconos. El fin de semana pasado, en la Arquidiócesis de Cincinnati, celebramos la ordenación de diáconos en la Basílica Catedral de San Pedro Encadenado.

Debemos recordar que cada uno de nosotros, a través de nuestro bautismo, somos ungidos con el mismo Espíritu Santo y llamados a ser evangelizadores, siervos de Dios. Cada uno de nosotros debe desempeñar su papel único para llevar a Jesús a los demás. Como afirma claramente el Papa Francisco en *Evangelii Gaudium*: "Todos los bautizados, cualquiera que sea su posición en la Iglesia o su nivel de instrucción en la fe, son agentes de evangelización, y sería insuficiente concebir un plan de evangelización llevado a cabo por profesionales mientras el resto de los fieles son meros receptores pasivos". 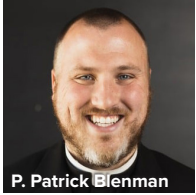
