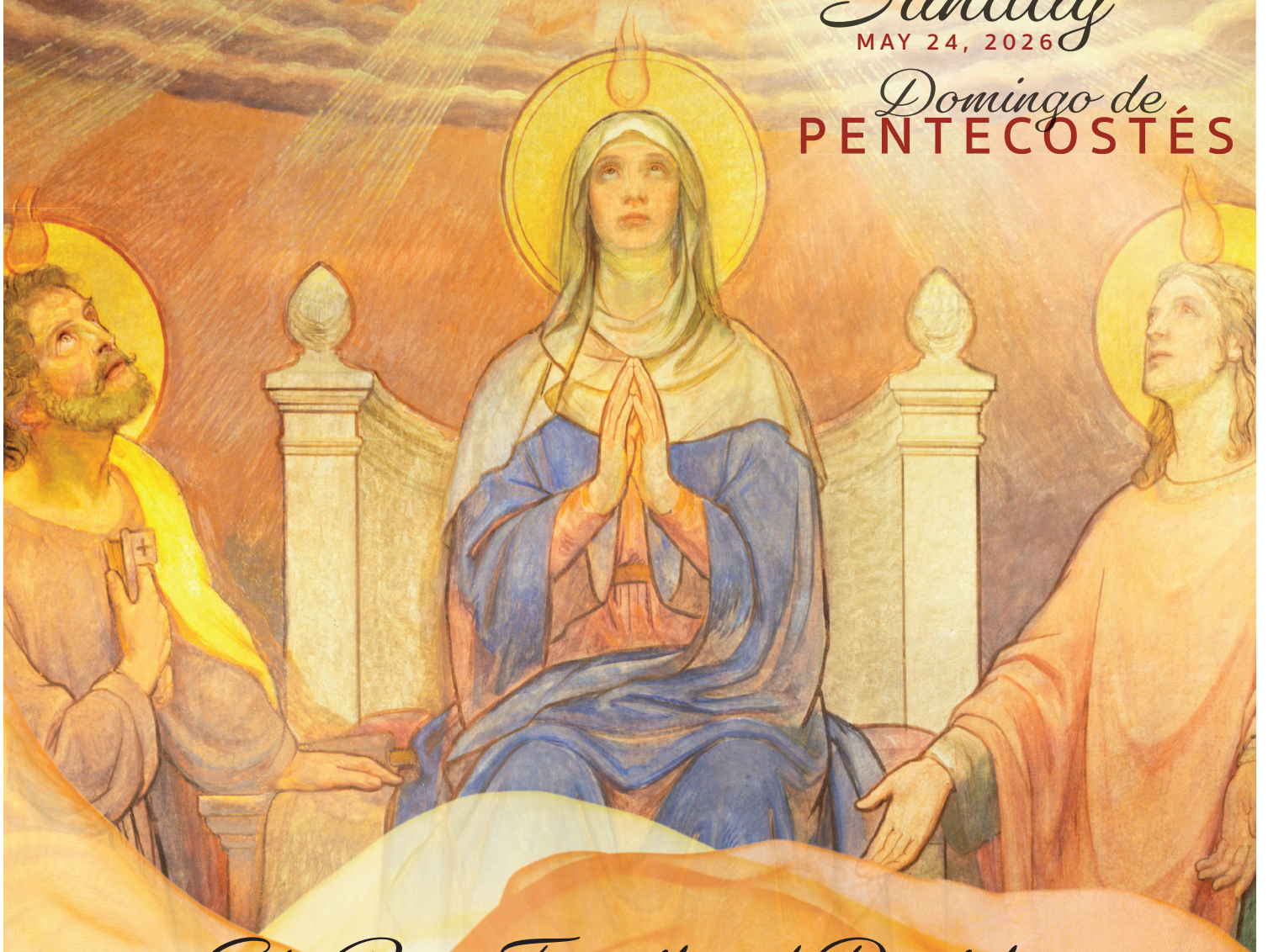

**From the Pastor**  
**May 24, 2026**

The Holy Spirit is God, and God is not to be trifled with. This is crucial never to forget in our lives as Christians. Spiritual things, unfortunately, lend themselves to being manipulated. Since spiritual things are not as immediately present. It is harder for us to manipulate material things. If there is a brick wall, we can't just pretend that it isn't a brick wall and that we can walk right through it. But with the spiritual, we can try to exercise our influence over it.

But with the Holy Spirit, who is God, we shouldn't try to do this at all. Instead, we should do what The Apostles do in the first reading (Acts 2:1-11): We should be docile to being led by the Holy Spirit. The Apostles receive the great gift of the Holy Spirit, the very unpredictable and powerful God. They probably didn't plan to do all of those things that day – they knew that, before the coming of the Holy Spirit, they did not have those abilities and powers – but everything changed when the Holy Spirit came. So let us be open to the powerful working of the Holy Spirit, not trying to manipulate the spiritual to fit our own ideas and plans.

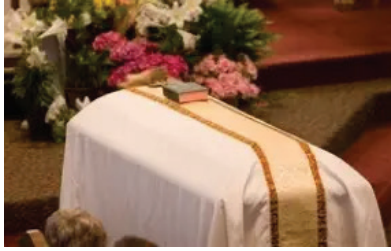



El Espíritu Santo es Dios, y con Dios no se juega. Es fundamental no olvidar esto jamás en nuestra vida como cristianos. Lamentablemente, las cosas espirituales se prestan a la manipulación. Dado que no son tan inmediatamente presentes, nos resulta más difícil manipular las cosas materiales. Si hay una pared de ladrillos, no podemos simplemente fingir que no lo es y que podemos atravesarla. Pero con lo espiritual, sí podemos intentar ejercer nuestra influencia.

Pero con el Espíritu Santo, que es Dios, no deberíamos intentar hacer esto en absoluto. En cambio, deberíamos hacer lo que hicieron los apóstoles en la primera lectura (Hechos 2:1-11): dejarnos guiar por el Espíritu Santo. Los apóstoles recibieron el gran don del Espíritu Santo, el Dios impredecible y poderoso. Probablemente no planearon hacer todo eso ese día —sabían que, antes de la venida del Espíritu Santo, no tenían esas habilidades ni poderes—, pero todo cambió cuando el Espíritu Santo vino. Así que estemos abiertos a la poderosa obra del Espíritu Santo, sin intentar manipular lo espiritual para que se ajuste a nuestras propias ideas y planes.


