From the Pastor

The Father is God. The Son is God. The Holy Spirit is God. There is only one God but three Persons. This mystery is challenging to grasp for our minds – actually, it is impossible to understand the whole. That is what we understand a mystery to be: something we can know something about, but not everything.

And what do we know about the mystery? We know that God has revealed Himself in this way. As St. John Paul II said, this is the “definitive self-revelation of the Triune God: a living unity in the communion of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.” We also know that, at the core, the mystery is love. “God is love,” says St. John. This communion, this relationship, it is love. And so today we can ask for a great grace: that this love, this theological virtue of charity would be even more infused into our hearts, in our covenantal union with the one true God in three Persons.




