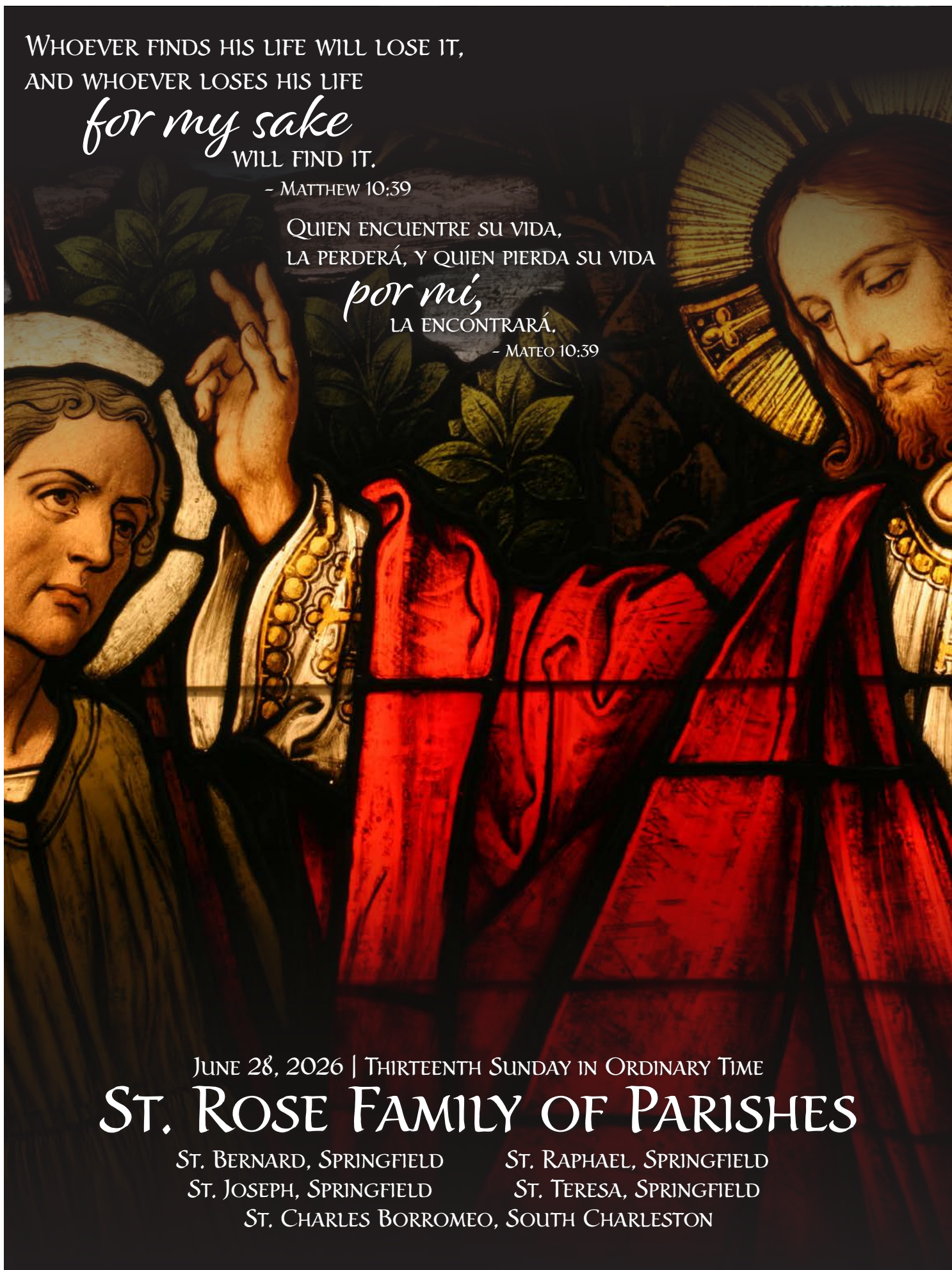

All are welcome to come share a meal, enjoy good company, and strengthen our parish community. The menu will change each month, so there's always something new to look forward to!

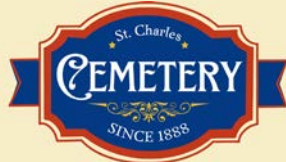

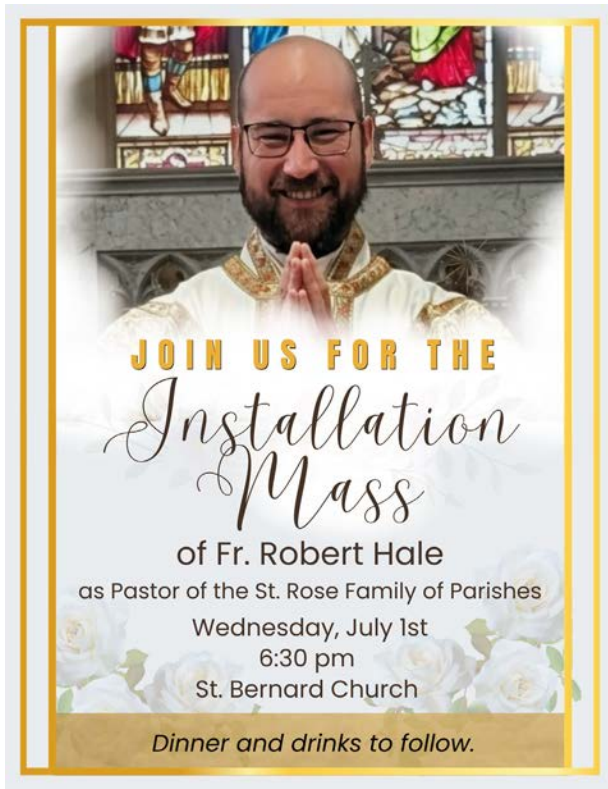

St. Teresa St. Vincent de Paul Needs Your Support

The St. Vincent de Paul Conferences at St. Teresa, St. Joseph, St. Bernard, and St. Raphael work together to assist Springfield families with overdue rent, utility, and other housing-related expenses. Our goal is to help individuals and families remain in their homes during difficult times. In most cases, we are helping people overcome temporary hardships caused by illness, the loss of a loved one, or job loss.

In October 2025, St. Teresa's St. Vincent de Paul Conference suspended home-visit assistance for one month due to low funding. Since resuming assistance in November 2025, we have helped 104 families through May 2026, providing more than **\$21,300** in aid, an average of **\$205.00 per household assisted**.

Unfortunately, our available funds are once again declining, and within the next month or two we may be forced to suspend our participation in this ministry if additional support is not received.

We recognize that many parishioners now attend Mass at other churches within the St. Rose Family of Parishes because of the current Mass schedule. We want to assure you that donations designated for **St. Teresa St. Vincent de Paul** can be placed in the collection at **any St. Rose Family of Parishes church**. Simply use your St. Teresa St. Vincent de Paul envelope or place your donation in a plain envelope marked "**St. Teresa SVPD**" with your name. Contributions will be forwarded to St. Teresa.

Saint Junipero Serra

Saint of the Day: July 1

Patron Saint of Vocations to Church Ministry, California, and Hispanic Americans

Born on Spain's island of Mallorca, Serra entered the Franciscan Order. Until he was 35, he spent most of his time in the classroom – first as a student of theology and then as a professor. He also became famous for his preaching. Suddenly he gave it all up and followed the yearning that had begun years before when he heard about the missionary work of Saint Francis Solano in South America. Junipero's desire was to convert native peoples in the New World.

Arriving by ship at Vera Cruz, Mexico, he and a companion walked the 250 miles to Mexico City. He became president of the missions there. Other missions followed: Monterey/Carmel (1770); San Antonio and San Gabriel (1771); San Luis Obispo (1772); San Francisco and San Juan Capistrano (1776); Santa Clara (1777); San Buenaventura (1782). Twelve more were founded after Serra's death.

Because the Native Americans were living a nonhuman life from the Spanish point of view, the friars were made their legal guardians. The Native Americans were kept at the mission after baptism lest they be corrupted in their former haunts – a move that has brought cries of "injustice."

Junipero Serra's missionary life was a long battle with cold and hunger, with unsympathetic military commanders and even with danger of death from non-Christian native peoples.
