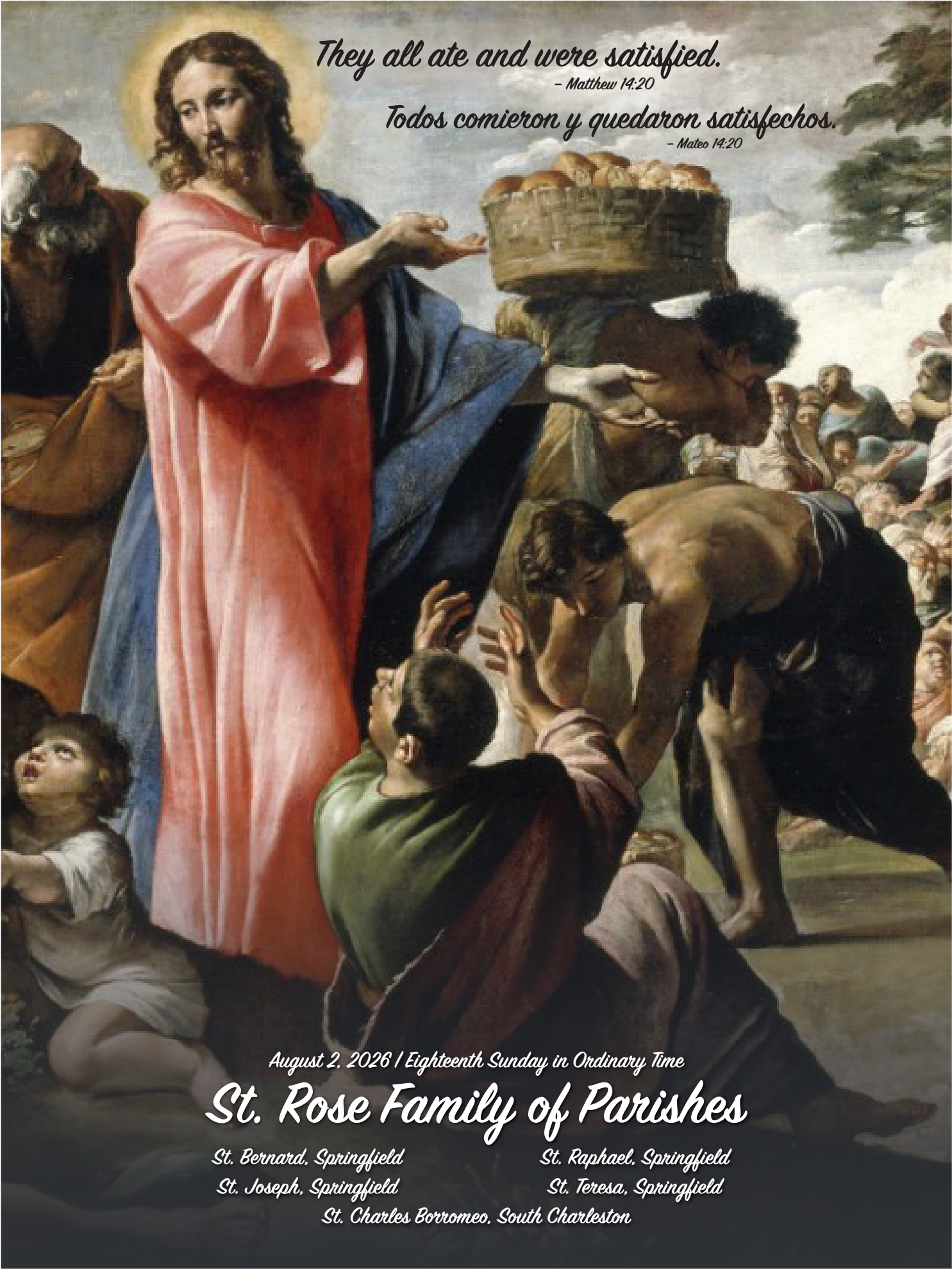

San Domingo

Santo del día: 8 de agosto

Patrono de los astrónomos y de la República Dominicana

Nacido en la antigua Castilla, España, Santo Domingo recibió formación para el sacerdocio de manos de un tío sacerdote, estudió las artes y la teología, y se convirtió en canónigo de la catedral de Osma, donde se intentaba revivir la vida comunitaria apostólica descrita en los Hechos de los Apóstoles.

Durante un viaje por Francia con su obispo, Domingo se enfrentó de frente a la entonces virulenta herejía albigense en Languedoc. Los albigenses sostenían que en el mundo existían dos principios: uno bueno y otro malo. Toda la materia es mala; por lo tanto, negaban la Encarnación y los sacramentos. Siguiendo el mismo principio, se abstenerían de procrear y consumían lo mínimo de comida y bebida. El círculo más cercano llevaba lo que algunos consideraban una vida heroica de pureza y ascetismo.

San Domingo percibió la necesidad de que la Iglesia combatiera esta herejía y recibió el encargo de formar parte de la cruzada de predicación contra ella. Inmediatamente comprendió por qué la cruzada de predicación no estaba teniendo éxito: la gente común admiraba y seguía a los héroes ascéticos de los albigenses. Como era de esperarse, no les impresionaban los predicadores católicos que viajaban a caballo y con séquito, se alojaban en las mejores posadas y contaban con sirvientes. Por lo tanto, Santo Domingo, junto con tres cistercienses, comenzó a predicar de manera itinerante según el ideal evangélico. Continuó esta labor durante 10 años, teniendo éxito entre la gente común, pero no entre los líderes.

Sus compañeros predicadores se fueron convirtiendo poco a poco en una comunidad, y en 1215 Domingo fundó una casa religiosa en Toulouse, lo que marcó el inicio de la Orden de los Predicadores o Dominicos.

El ideal de Domingo, y el de su Orden, era vincular orgánicamente una vida con Dios, el estudio y la oración en todas sus formas, con un ministerio de salvación para las personas a través de la palabra de Dios. Su ideal: contemplata tradere: “transmitir los frutos de la contemplación” o “hablar solo de Dios o con Dios.”

Saint Dominic

Saint of the Day: August 8

Patron Saint of Astronomers and the Dominican Republic

Born in old Castile, Spain, Saint Dominic was trained for the priesthood by a priest-uncle, studied the arts and theology, and became a canon of the cathedral at Osma, where there was an attempt to revive the apostolic common life described in Acts of the Apostles.

On a journey through France with his bishop, Dominic came face to face with the then virulent Albigensian heresy at Languedoc. The Albigensians held to two principles – one good, one evil – in the world. All matter is evil – hence they denied the Incarnation and the sacraments. On the same principle, they abstained from procreation and took a minimum of food and drink. The inner circle led what some people regarded as a heroic life of purity and asceticism.

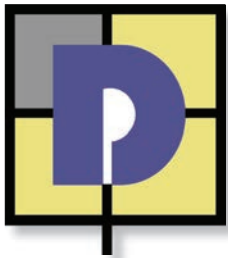

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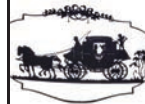
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
