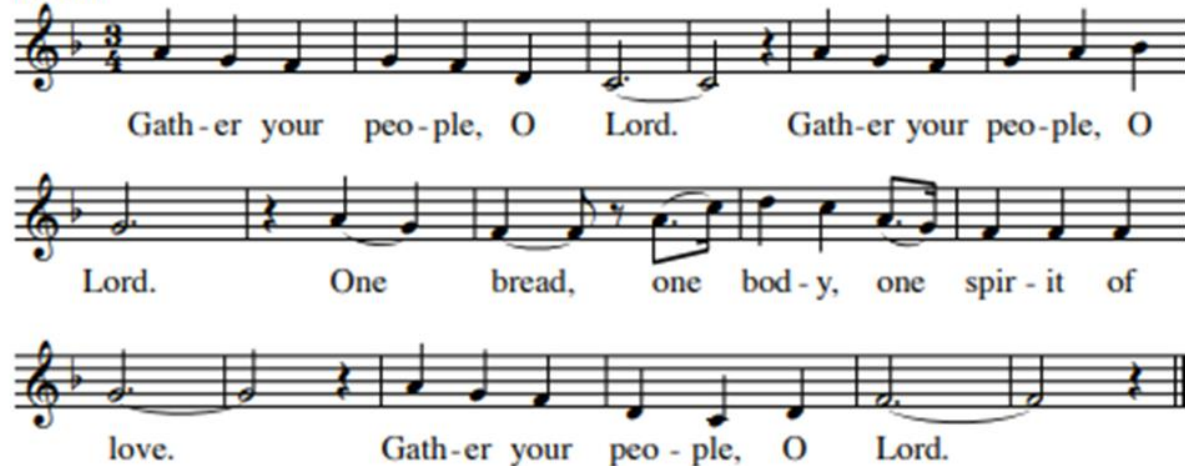

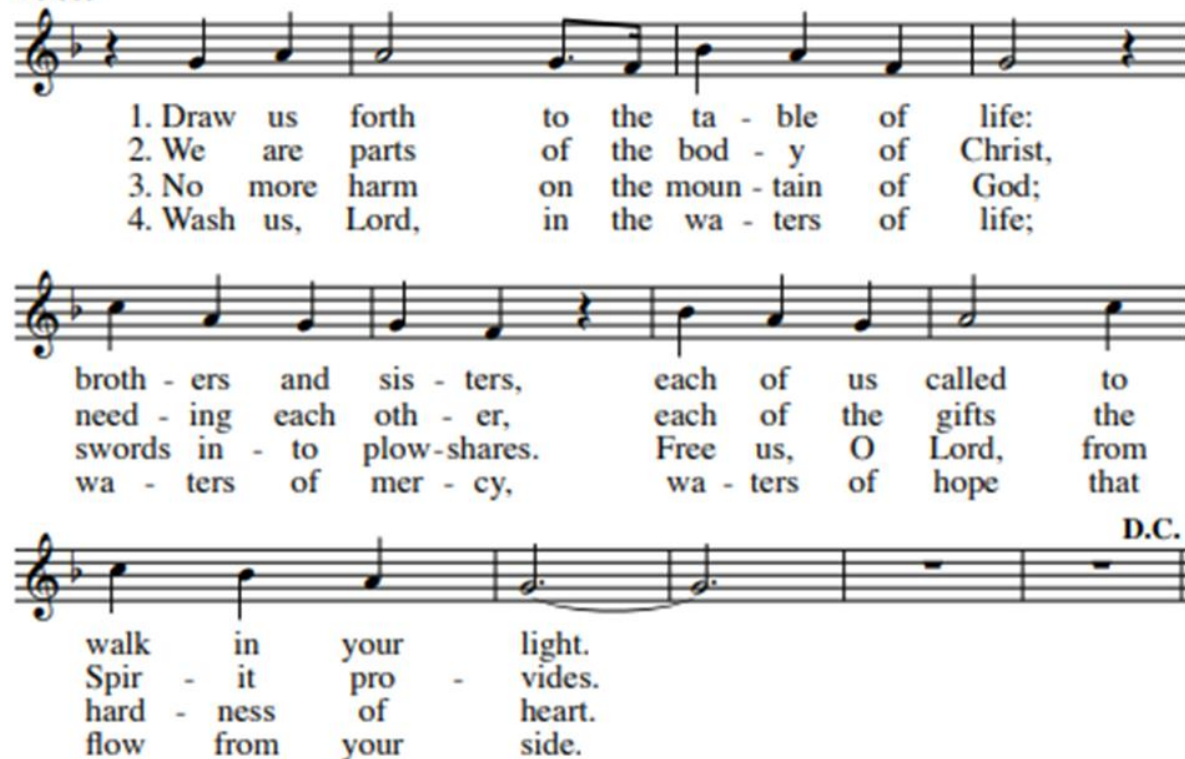

food for the hungry, life for the weary,

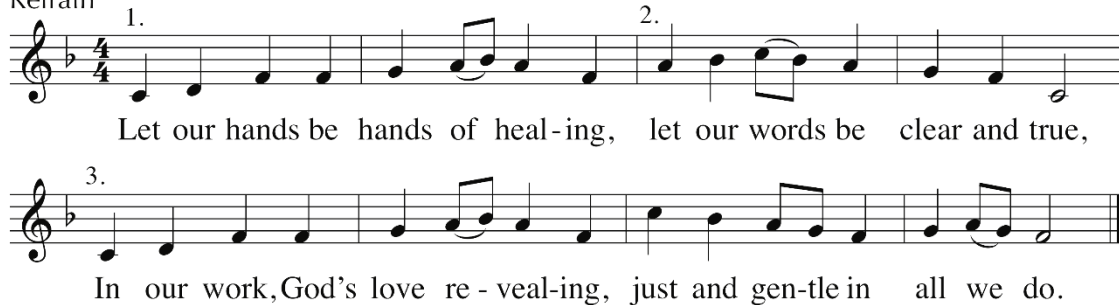
