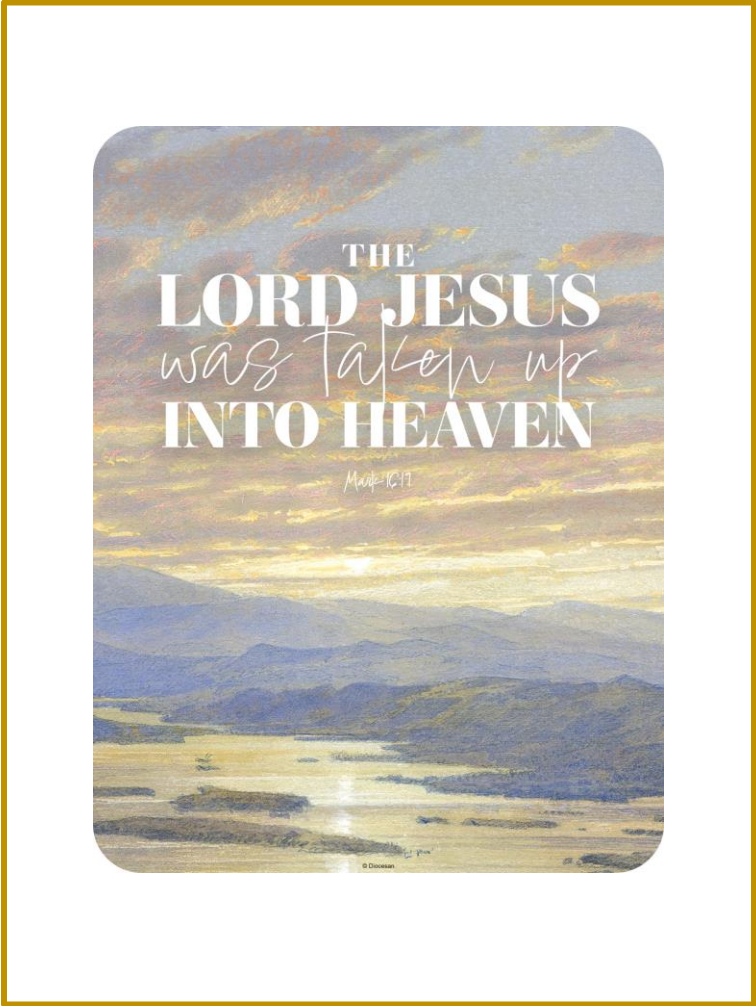

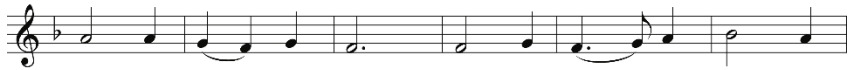

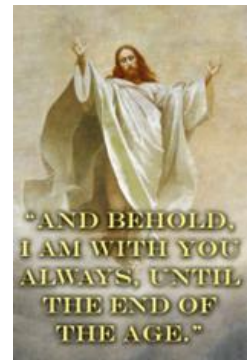

### ***Nicene Creed***
