From the Pastor
May 10, 2026

In today's Gospel, Jesus, at the Last Supper, both tells the disciples to show their love for Him by keeping His commands and promises them the Holy Spirit to help them to live out their calling as His close followers. The motet "If Ye Love Me" written by Thomas Tallis around the year 1549 is a beautiful musical setting of this Gospel. I strongly encourage you to look up and listen to this piece, if you have not yet heard it – there's a really beautiful version of it by the musical group Tenebrae on YouTube. The polyphony of this piece, probably the most popular piece of music that Tallis wrote, is so masterful in its complexity but also its simplicity. That same dynamic can be used to describe the command of Jesus.

On the face of it, Jesus' commands are simple. Love God and love others. Even the expansion that He gives at the Last Supper – "love as I have loved you" – does not complicate things too much. But when it comes to living out these commands, things get complicated. We do not live in a starkly black and white world, but there are many grey areas that challenge us to discern what is good and what is not. So many other factors can enter in and complicate things. What is left for us is to try to weave some beautiful polyphony out of the simplicity of the command and the complexity of our lives. And we know that we have the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, to assist us in living out the commands of Jesus.

Bring your family, invite a friend, and stay after Mass for great food and fellowship.

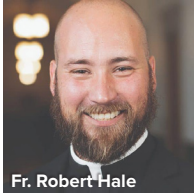

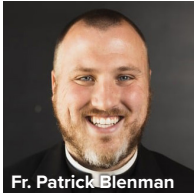

Del Pastor

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús, en la Última Cena, les dice a sus discípulos que le demuestren su amor guardando sus mandamientos y les promete el Espíritu Santo para ayudarlos a cumplir su vocación como fieles seguidores. El motete «Si me amáis», compuesto por Thomas Tallis alrededor del año 1549, es una hermosa adaptación musical de este Evangelio. Les recomiendo encarecidamente que busquen y escuchen esta pieza, si aún no lo han hecho; hay una versión realmente hermosa del grupo musical Tenebrae en YouTube. La polifonía de esta pieza, probablemente la obra más popular de Tallis, es magistral tanto por su complejidad como por su sencillez. Esa misma dinámica puede usarse para describir el mandato de Jesús.

A primera vista, los mandamientos de Jesús son sencillos: amar a Dios y amar al prójimo. Incluso la explicación que da en la Última Cena — “amad como yo os he amado” — no complica demasiado las cosas. Pero cuando se trata de poner en práctica estos mandamientos, la cosa se complica. No vivimos en un mundo de blanco y negro absoluto, sino que existen muchas zonas grises que nos desafían a discernir entre el bien y el mal. Muchos otros factores pueden entrar en juego y complicar las cosas. Lo que nos queda es intentar crear una hermosa polifonía a partir de la sencillez del mandamiento y la complejidad de nuestras vidas. Y sabemos que contamos con el Espíritu Santo, el Consolador, para ayudarnos a vivir los mandamientos de Jesús.

Familia de Parroquias de Santa Rosa – Anuncio Importante Transición del liderazgo parroquial

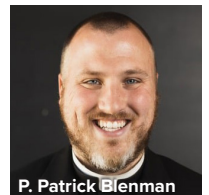
