Prague: One of the most fascinating cities in Europe – with a rich history in photography!

Workshop for applied photography with large format cameras and black and white film.
Led by Detlef Grosspietsch and Johannes Bockemühl (JOBO) and Lubos (fotoSkoda)





About Prague

Prague feels like an open-air museum. Within a short walk you can shoot:

Gothic (e.g., Charles Bridge tower)

Baroque (St. Nicholas Church)

Art Nouveau (Municipal House)

Cubism (House of the Black Madonna)

Modern minimalism

This variety gives photographers endless subjects and teaches how to adapt to different visual languages.

It also has one of the oldest Jewish Cemeteries of Europe – and offers peaceful urban surroundings.

2. Dreamy Light & Atmosphere

The city often has **soft, cinematic morning mist**, especially near the Vltava River. At sunrise, rooftops and spires glow warmly, while evenings give long shadows and reflections. .

Who is the workshop aimed at?

Amateur or professional photographers who would like to apply and/or deepen their knowledge of large format cameras, analog large format photography and film processing in the fascinating City and surroundings of Prague.

Number of participants: Minimum 6, maximum 8

Prerequisites for participation

Basic knowledge of large format cameras and analog large format photography is required for participation. However, during the workshop there will be the opportunity to explore all desired technical/practical aspects individually with the instructors.

Description

Five days of photography in Prague and surroundings with Foto Skoda and Detlef Grosspietsch, an experienced professional photographer, printer and innovator. Instructors will take the participants to the most interesting places to discover the city of Prague, the Jewish Cemetery and some beautiful urban places in the region. The B&W Lab and Darkroom of Foto Skoda in downtown will allow us to develop images daily and comment them together on a light table and PC. Each participant will be accompanied in the best possible way and, among other things, bring their own point of view and approach to the subject.

The program in an overview

Wednesday (Sept 16) : Arrival of the participants in the early afternoon, accommodation in the hotel.

This is followed by an introduction to the workshop. Dinner and overnight stay.

Thursday & Friday (Sep 17 & 18): Photography days in the City, constantly changing locations and motifs to be photographed. Picnic Lunch. Special Highlight: Jewish Cemetery Zizkove. Return to the hotel in the afternoon and develop the exposed films in the lab.

After dinner: time to discuss the work done.

Saturday, Sep 19: Urban photography in the surroundings (Cesky Kras) with Lubos, a local expert from Foto SKODA.

Sunday, Sep 20: Final comments on the workshop, time for questions and insights. Farewell and free departure.

Logistics

Our accommodation is nice hotel in central Prague . Accommodation is in double rooms or single rooms. Dinner will be taken in various restaurants. Participants must arrive with their own vehicle. For the photo shoots we will use the available means of transportation.
