

Westwood Golf Club – General Rules

Respect Club Staff and Follow Their Direction

All members and guests are expected to treat Club staff with courtesy and respect at all times. Please follow the direction of the Golf Staff while on Club property. Any concerns or disputes should be addressed respectfully with the General Manager at a later time.

Care for the Golf Course and Respect Fellow Members

Maintain Proper Pace of Play

Groups are expected to keep pace with the group ahead at all times. The maximum pace of play is four hours per round. During non-peak times, groups should complete rounds in less time whenever possible. Cart path only pace of play: 4:10

Protect Native Grass Areas

Golf carts and push carts are not permitted in native grass areas. These environmentally sensitive areas can be damaged by unnecessary traffic.

Repair Ball Marks on Greens

Ball marks must be repaired carefully and immediately upon reaching the green to help maintain smooth putting surfaces for all players.

Repair Divots Properly

All divots in fairways and the short game practice area must be repaired using the provided divot mix. Divots in the rough and on Par 3 tees should also be repaired.

Rake Bunkers After Use

Players are expected to rake bunkers thoroughly after use. All footprints, depressions, and disturbed sand should be smoothed to leave the bunker in proper playing condition for the following group. Tap excess sand from your shoes before exiting the bunker

Use Practice Balls Only in Designated Areas

Practice balls are permitted only within designated practice facilities. Use of practice balls on the golf course is considered a serious rules violation.

Operate Golf Carts Responsibly

Golf carts must remain on designated cart paths surrounding all tees and greens. Minimize driving in the rough and don't drive in wet areas and create ruts. Keep push carts off greens and collars.

All golf cart movement throughout the course must comply with the daily cart restrictions and notices posted by the Golf Shop. These restrictions are implemented to protect the course based on weather and turf conditions

Course Access and Play

Begin Play on Hole #1 Unless Approved by the Golf Shop

All rounds must begin on Hole #1 and follow the designated course routing unless prior approval has been granted by the Golf Shop. Players may not skip holes, jump around the course, or practice on the golf course outside of an authorized playing lesson with the Golf Staff.

Dress Code

Wear Proper Golf Attire

Appropriate golf attire is required at all times while on Club property.

Men – must wear collared shirts and be tucked in, and slacks or golf shorts that are of acceptable golf length. Caps, if worn, must be worn with the bill facing forward.

Women – Dresses, skirts, skorts, slacks, shorts, and blouses (with or without sleeves) are considered appropriate attire. Sleeveless tops must have a collar. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be of conservative tailoring and appropriate golf length. Leggings or yoga pants, unless worn under an appropriate length skirt or shorts, are not allowed.

Food and Beverage Policy

No Outside Food or Beverage

All food and beverages consumed on Club property must be purchased through Westwood Golf Club. Outside food, beverages, coolers, and alcoholic beverages are prohibited unless expressly authorized by Club management.
