He champions the UN's mandates and advocates for the delivery of the MSDf in close collaboration with national governments and regional institutions. A key focus is strengthening cooperation and effectiveness of UN operational activities throughout the region. Prior to his leadership role in Moldova, Mr. Springett served as Chief Operating Officer & Deputy Director for Response Operations at the UK Department for International Development / Palladium. Additionally, he also served as the United Nations RC, UNDP Resident Representative, and the UNFPA Representative for both Mauritius and the Seychelles (2012-2017). He also held senior leadership positions with Oxfam, specializing in rapid humanitarian responses. Mr. Springett has also served as a Director and Trustee of a number of international organizations. In addition to his development expertise, Mr. Springett will also serve as the UN Designated Official for Security (DO) for 13 countries and territories in the Eastern Caribbean, ensuring the safety and security of all UN personnel and their dependents in the region.*
