# Pulpit Anniversary

Mother Bean is one of the first people to join the Pulpit Committee. Mother Bean stated "the Pulpit Committee in 1998 was called Pulpit Aide, and then Pulpit Ministry, and now Pulpit Committee. Her reason for joining was because she was appointed to do so." Mother Bean also stated "she joined because she knew Bishop Cook and Evangelist Cook were God-fearing people." She has been walking along side them for 21 years. She stated "the bible says know them that labor among you, 1 Thessalonians 5:12. Sister Pittman gave her experience which was that it was well put together! The Pulpit Committee is doing an excellent job! It was professionally put together and you can tell the Pulpit Committee put their all into it! The anniversary celebration of the Pulpit Committee began at 5:00pm, with New Grace Temple Ministries guest speaker, Pastor Brian McKnight from Monument of Faith Outreach Ministries in Latta, SC.

Apostle Vivian Troy of Bethel Word Ministries of Mullins, SC shared an elaborate teaching with the Ladies, while Pastor Anthony Howard broke bread with the Men of Grace. Then we had some of NGT finest, Elder Michael McMillian, Minister Sheera Myers, and Minister Quintin Jones, share amongst our youth; Bishop Cook ministered to seniors, 55 and up. 
