

Important Information!

Regarding Your Single Stop Office Visit:

- Plan for a visit time of 20-45 minutes, which includes completing a web-based screening tool, assessment and resource counseling.
- Screening must be completed online by accessing the following link from ANY Wi-Fi device:
app.singlestop.org/hindscs/main
- The web based screening tool utilizes the information you enter and determines if you are eligible for local or federal resources.
- Upon submitting the web-based screening tool, an email tickler will be sent to the Single Stop office and a Single Stop Coordinator will contact you to schedule a time for your one-on-one resource counseling.
- Your one-on-one resource counseling session will discuss potential local and federal resources, and provide assistance with securing the identified resources from the external public service agency. This includes, but is not limited to, application submission, document/documentation assistance, advocacy, and preparation for the external agency visit.
- Resources are awarded by the external public service agency upon your compliance with the referral process. Your Single Stop Coordinator is available and willing to assist you throughout the entire process.

Why seek assistance from a Hinds CC Single Stop office?

Single Stop is a one-stop source for students and immediate family members to be connected to public benefits and local resources. Single Stop offer students a wide array of services including benefits screening, free tax preparation, financial coaching, legal resources, community closet for students, health insurance assistance and free/sliding scale medical resources.

Single Stop's holistic approach offers students and their families wrap-around services to eliminate barriers that affect academic retention and graduation. Single Stop utilizes a unique web-based program to quickly screen and determine eligibility for multiple government benefits. Single Stop coordinators explain and assist the students with applying for benefits that meet their identified needs.

Hinds Community College established a partnership with Single Stop USA, a national initiative, with the goal of increasing students economic stability by identifying and providing resources to address life stressors so that the student can complete college.



In the Single Stop Office at Hinds Community College, we provide a safety net when life stressors happen, inspiration for those who need it, a bit of hope and connections to valuable resources that can help students succeed.

Services offered in the Hinds CC Single Stop Office:

All services provided by the Single Stop Office are **FREE** to all Hinds Community College students and immediate family members.

Benefit screenings for federal and state benefits such as:

- **SNAP:** Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- **TANF:** Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- **LIHEAP:** Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program

- **Eligibility determination** for Earned Income, Education or Child Tax Credits
- **Financial Counseling:** Financial advice and counseling from Single Stop Coordinators and/or referral to financial professionals
- **Legal Counseling:** Assessment and referral to legal agencies that partner with HCC Single Stop
- **Community Closet:** Gently used clothing and shoes for students
- **Health Insurance Screening:** Free or sliding scale medical care referral
- **Transportation:** Student discounts for day, monthly and semester bus passes
