## From your minister, Summer 2026

Heading into the long hot summer, our monthly theme (which underscores and envelopes everything we do) in June, is *flourishing together*. I'll say this as plainly as I can - flourishing is impossible without the together part. The only way for us to reach our full potential as individuals is in community. And when every individual is flourishing, then so does the community. This is the heart of interdependence. As Dr. Robin Wall Kimmerer, one of my favorite people, says, "All flourishing is mutual."

In recognition of this truth, we reflected on the following question at our recent worship arts meeting while planning for the month: "What circle of care and support helped you discover your unique brand of flourishing? i.e. what circle helped you know yourself in a way you couldn't have on your own?" Each person in attendance (which was a lot because the group has really grown recently!) shared some beautiful answers. Some of which I'll amplify during worship on June 7<sup>th</sup>.

Also on June 7<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate and perform the time-honored UU ritual of the flower ceremony. A perfect symbol of flourishing together. *Please bring a flower to add to our altar...* symbolizing the flourishing garden which emerges from the presence of each of us. Then, we'll further illustrate how well we are indeed flourishing together right now as a faith community when Ed McCranie takes a photo of us all following the service! I'm looking forward to the good problem of figuring out how to fit everybody in! I really hope you can make a point of being there and be a part of this historical snapshot in time!

An ecosystem requires deep, connected roots to flourish. In many ways, we feed each other in the more visible bits 'above ground.' Yet, we also provide nourishment and enrichment for each other in deeper, less seen ways. **And** even though flourishing requires together, we also need to be somewhat intentional about strengthening ourselves so that we might add more fully... more whole-y... more holy... together. And therefore, we have a responsibility to strengthen and deepen our own roots.

Which requires spiritual practice.

I've been suggesting spiritual practices to go along with each theme all year. I'm not going to suggest anything specific this time. Just urge you to use whatever spiritual practices have been effective for you in the past. Be intentional about it. Maybe even disciplined. Maybe even do it every day. Form a taproot for yourself... make it extra hard for life to uproot you. Knowing that your own internal, "within' work,' doesn't just benefit you.

Then watch *us* grow. Feel *us* flourish!

May it continue to be so.

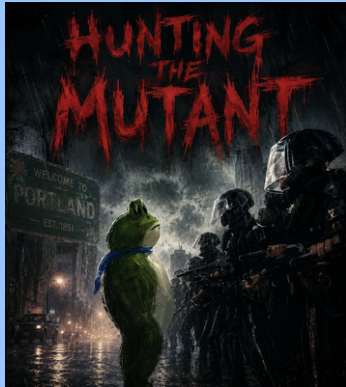

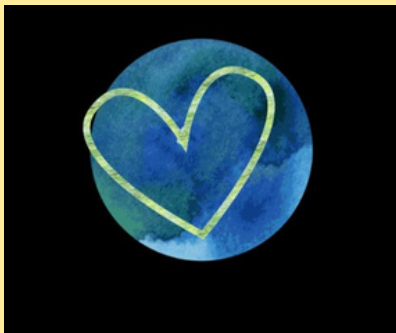

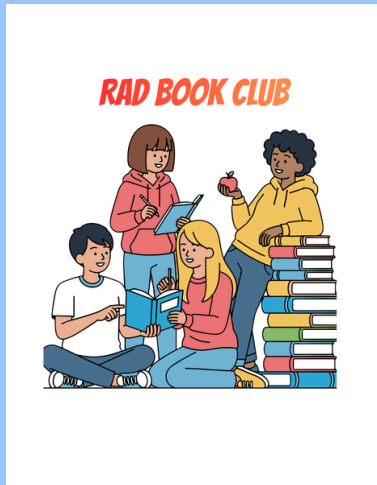
