

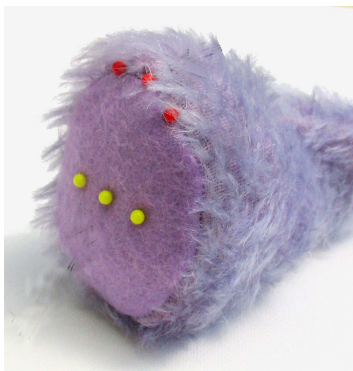
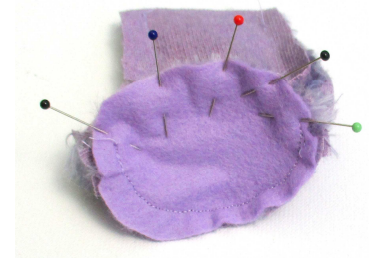
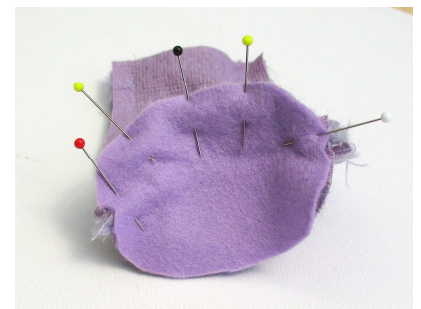


Felt footpads and simple embroidered toes



- Before attaching the footpads, make a couple of snips into the leg seam (avoid your stitches !). This will allow the

- Mark the center front and back of the footpad and pin these to the seams. Continue pinning down one side only (pins at right angles to the edge)
- Tack down the pinned side from toe to heel. Then sew your final stitches in place on that side too. You may find hand sewing this with back stitch will give a neater result.
- Repeat on the opposite side.



- Turn the leg through and tease any fur that may be trapped in the seams.
- Next pin the base of each toe and mark the top of the toe with pins, using the foot seam as your guide
- Note that we are actually pinning “between” the toes. If you use 3 pins, you will have 4 toes. For 3 toes, just use 2 pins.
- Anchor your thread by going through the foot 3 or 4 times until you feel the thread “catch” in the stuffing.

- Take the thread out at the first pin (removing the pin). Then into the pin above.
- Come out at the next pin and move along the foot this way.
- Work back along toes one more time, then finish by taking the thread through the foot 2 or 3 times again and cut the thread.
