




A GOOD STORY FROM JOANIE ABOUT LIVING WATERS



When I was in Mexico in 2007, working on a new water system installation, a little boy named Obed was among the children who came to learn about the proper uses of the clean water that would soon be available to his community in Campeche. The photo below on the left is Obed at three years old. He was a happy, outgoing child, but his mother shared that he was often ill, usually due to water-borne disease. She feared that these frequent bouts of illness would affect his growth and his learning. She was so grateful to know that he would now have access to safe water.

Last month, I was once again in the Yucatan peninsula for the annual gathering of all the operators of our Living Waters purification systems in that Network. And to my delight, Obed was present! He is now 20 years old, and is one of the operators of the water system that was installed in his church when he was a toddler. Happy and healthy, as you can see in the photo on the right!

Largely because of the clean water he had as he grew up, Obed is reaching his God-given potential, and giving back to the ministry that has afforded him that possibility.

I am deeply grateful for this ministry that is now making good health possible for literally thousands of people who now have access to this basic human right – pure water. This is truly God's hand at work in the world in a sustainable way. And I pray that it will continue as we reach for the goal of clean water for all God's children!
