We began Holy Week in grand style as usual, with our bell and sanctuary choirs leading us in resounding worship, our young (and not-so-young) disciples bringing joyful enthusiasm to the palm procession! For many churchgoers, there's a straight line from the joy of Palm Sunday to the joy of Easter Sunday. But the invitation every year is to spend more time with Jesus during Holy Week than simply showing up on Easter Sunday for the "mighty triumph o'er his foes," as one of the beloved Easter Hymns I grew up with puts it. So much happens between those two Sundays, and we're invited to reflect on all of it. For some of us, that involves reading more scripture than usual, the Gospels spending a great deal of time covering the events of those eight days. For others, we listen to classical music (Bach's St. Matthew's Passion anyone?) or contemporary worship music. Some of us will, no doubt, wish we had time to do some of those things, but are just trying to keep our head above water as we navigate our seemingly endless to-do lists and schedules.

If your schedule and energy levels allow, I hope you'll join us for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services this week. At 5:30pm on Thursday we'll gather around a single table in the Fellowship Hall to share a simple meal, before continuing with a service of Holy Communion and footwashing around that table at 6:30pm. On Friday, we'll gather in the Sanctuary for a service of Tenebrae ("darkness"), with scripture readings, hymns and choral music, as we gather at the foot of the cross together. And then on Easter morning we'll feast together at 9:30am with our annual brunch, before we gather in the Sanctuary at 11:00am to celebrate the resurrection. I invite you to take a little time to think of someone(s) you know who does not have a church home currently, but who may welcome an invitation to join you for some or all of the opportunities we have to observe a meaningful Holy Week together. And then invite them!

See you soon - and on this of all weeks, let me remind you that the best is yet to come!

There will be an Easter Egg Hunt after worship on Sunday. Don't forget to bring your Easter baskets!


PRESBYDAN MAH JONGG


