Friends,

If you were able to join us for Easter Sunday, I pray that the joy of that glorious morning continues to resound in you today. In the homily, I reflected on the hopes and fears that make up the warp and weft of the tapestry of our lives. The joy and grief that so often intermingles, so that even in our happiest moments, that which we fear may tap on our shoulder, and even in those moments when we are grief-stricken, we can still find ourselves laughing at times. I'm sure that is true for many of us today, as we feel the initial grief of losing John Erwin, a beloved member of our congregation and the wider community. A memory will pop into mind from seemingly nowhere, and we may well find ourselves laughing even as the tears roll down our cheeks. No doubt that will be true when we gather together sometime in the next few days to celebrate John's life with God, and to commend him to God's care in death. And in the rawness of our personal grief, and our grief for John's family, it may be difficult to fully embrace the words with which I concluded the Easter homily: Easter hope is the quiet, insistent belief that the worst things are never the last things. Those words capture the heart of our faith - but they may just feel like words to some of us at the moment. If so, may we lean on each other's faith when our own feels a little shaky, as the warp and weft of our lives adds a new row to the tapestry.

May the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

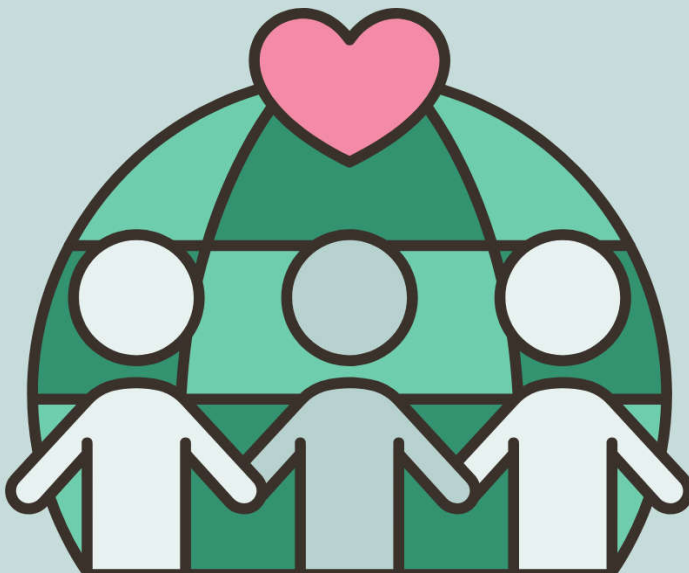
