Advent: History, Mystery & Majesty

There's a tradition of speaking of Advent as the time when we recall how Jesus comes in history, mystery, and majesty. Jesus came in **history**, when he was **born** in the first century in Bethlehem. We remember and anticipate his birth in the Advent season. Jesus *still* comes to us in **mystery**, through the sacrament of communion, and whenever we gather together for **worship** ("Where two or three are gathered, I am in the midst of them," Jesus says). And so we sing, "Be born in us *today*." Finally, in the season of Advent, we don't only look back at history to the birth of Jesus in history, nor to the present and his ongoing presence with us in mystery, but we also anticipate the future and his coming again in glory, or... **majesty.**





Session Meeting October 21, 2025

Dennis Kaan was elected Acting Clerk while Jackie Reynolds is out of town.

There were two funerals.

Thank you notes were received from the following missions: Rev. Betsey Moe thanking the church for our support of the PCUSA mission coworker program and CEDEPCA (Protestant ministry in Guatemala); Office of Stewardship & Funds Development for our contribution to the Peace & Global Witness offering; the Alzheimer's Association; Sterling Advocates for Recovery; and Rod Schaefer for letting him use the church for his mother's funeral lunch.

It was noted that donations to the General Fund have been received in memory of Marilyn Ross in the amount of \$1,000 and from the Agnes Rundus estate in the amount of \$9,000.

Approved the September Transaction Detail report.

Approved the use of Walmart Pay in place of the discontinued Walmart Credit cards.

A draft budget was developed. No action was taken

It was voted to explore the creation of a music internship with young adults (typically NJC students).

Approved changes to the Chancel Choir Director job description and a 5% salary increase for the Chancel Choir Director effective immediately (October 2025) to compensate for additional responsibilities.

Called Session Meeting November 2, 2025

Approved to increase the Endowment Fund Sauter Corpus spending distribution from 5% to 6% annually

Approved to increase the Mineral/Thornton Fund spending distribution from 4% to 6% annually

Approved reaching out to Jim Leh regarding possible changes to distribution of the ELMST Fund
