Auction will be for anyone who wishes to buy or sell remote control aircraft, supplies, or any related tools or accessories. A fee of 20% of the sale price (minimum fee \$5.00) will be charged if you sell an item during the auction.

Whether you wish to buy or sell, please preregister online using the QR code provided below. If you wish to sell, you will also need to separately register each item for sale via an online item registration link which will be e-mailed to you after you register.

When you arrive at the auction, please check in at the registration table to get your bidder number. This is essential for both buyers and sellers, because it's how we account for all transactions. Even if you don't plan to buy or sell, it's safer to have a bidder number in case you change your mind!

If you didn't preregister, there will be a limited number of laptop computers available at the registration table for this purpose. But we strongly recommend that you preregister online beforehand to save time, especially if you have items to sell. All items offered for sale must be checked in and individually labeled with your bidder number and an item number.



Proceeds will be split with the Wings Predators drone soccer team which will be in full force to assist with the event. They will also be the entertainment for the event at half time

The Wings Predators drone soccer team is ranked third in the nation and going for the GOLD this year. They were the District 9 (Our AMA district) Champions.

Auction detail and preparation of your auctioned items:

Items of \$25.00 or less should be boxed together and will have the same item number. Combined items should have at least a \$25.00 value. Any item that does not sell will be charged a \$5.00 pass fee.

When you arrive at the museum:

All items for auction will enter through the north center door of the museum located on the north side of the building. There will be assistants at the door to help you with your paperwork. Then your registered items will be put on display tables on the way to the auction block. After items are auctioned off, they go to a holding area and are grouped by your bidder number. After checking out, you will receive your statement and retrieve your purchased items from the holding area. Please exit through the security checkpoint at the north door.

Forms of payment:

Cash, VISA, Mastercard, Paypal. Sorry no checks accepted

If you would just like to donate an item and not personally get anything for it, all proceeds would go to the club and Predators.
