The Rite of Chrismation

The Rite of Chrismation is performed immediately after baptism, because where there is life, there is breath. Holy Chrism, a fragrant mixture of oils and other components, symbolizes the richness and diversity of the spiritual gifts which the Holy Spirit grants to newborn in Christ.

Holy Chrism is consecrated on Holy & Great Thursday, the day before Good Friday by the Bishop for used by priests, which evidence is the unity of the Church.

During the rite of Chrismation, the priest anoints the baptized on the forehead, eyes, nostrils, lips, ears, breasts, hands, and feet. He proclaims each time: “The Seal of the Gift of the Holy Spirit.” Thus, in every word, indeed, the baptized is to please God and become a son/daughter and heir of his Kingdom. The Holy Spirit transfigures, the thoughts, feelings, and deeds of those who are members of the Kingdom.

Sixth Sunday After Pentecost

Christians belongs to God and are his possession because we were marked with the seal of the promise of the Holy Spirit; this is the pledge of our inheritance toward redemption as God's own people to the praise of his glory. It is through the power, and the action of the Holy Spirit, that the Christian lives in Christ. "The anointing that you received from him abides in you, and so you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things, and is true, and it's not a lie, and just as it has taught you, abide in him." (1 John 2:27)
