STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Students are required to consistently understand and follow the PADA Standards at all times.

The PADA Standards can be accessed through the PADA website by selecting "PADA Standards" from our website's menu.

Pay close attention when your teachers are speaking, and if you don't understand something, simply raise your hand to ask a question.

During breaks or while waiting for the teacher, all students are expected to gather together in the centre of the room, either seated or standing in a single group, ensuring that everyone is included in the conversation and no student is excluded.

Complete the full PADA class warm-up is required prior to participating in any acro skills, aerial skills, stretching, dance activities, or classes.

Follow directions from teachers, staff, and student leaders first time.

They're here to help you, support you & keeping you safe.

Students who have any issues, concerns, or anxieties are encouraged to speak with a PADA Staff Member. *Please note that certified assistant teachers who are students at PADA are not staff members. PADA staff are available to offer support and assistance.*

All students are required to bring a full bottle of water and two yoga blocks to every class.

Students are advised to walk around mats rather than across them unless specifically directed otherwise. It is important to consistently aware of your surroundings during classes and while practicing skills.

PADA maintains a phone-free environment for students. All mobile devices are to be placed in the designated phone box located near the teacher's desk. *If you need to contact your parents, please request assistance from a PADA staff member to use the academy phone.*
